Delegation of Additional Powers Relating To Sale

RECOMMENDATION:

This item requests that the City Council adopt an Ordinance conferring upon and delegating to the Board of Harbor Commissioners certain additional powers and duties relating to the sale of real property at Broadway and Golden Avenue, adjacent to the World Trade Center.

DISCUSSION

In June 2011 the Port purchased the 5.6-acre parcel located at the southeast corner of Broadway and Golden Avenue. The property is subject to a parking easement agreement that allows the site to be used as a parking lot by the Hilton Long Beach Hotel and World Trade Center office building. Under the City's Downtown Plan, the property can be developed with various high density uses with a maximum allowable height of 500 feet. Any parking spaces displaced by development are required to be replaced by the construction of a parking structure. Currently, the highest and best use of the site is the development of a high density residential project.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action to adopt Delegation of Additional Powers Relating to Sale is requested on August 23, 2016.

SUGGESTED ACTION

The Port now desires to sell the property. In order for the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) to negotiate and execute the necessary documents for the sale of the property, it is necessary that such authority be conferred upon and delegated to the Board. Therefore, the City Council desires to confer upon and delegate to the Board the power and duty to negotiate the sale of the property and to take all actions and enter into any agreements necessary to do so.



ORDINANCE NO.

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AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CONFERRING UPON AND DELEGATING TO THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS CERTAIN ADDITIONAL POWERS AND DUTIES RELATING TO THE SALE OF PROPERTY AT BROADWAY AND GOLDEN AVENUE, ADJACENT TO THE WORLD TRADE CENTER

WHEREAS, Section 1204 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach empowers the City Council, by ordinance, to confer upon and delegate to the Board of Harbor Commissioners such additional powers and duties which the City Council deems necessary or convenient to carry out the general purposes of such Board, subject to the approval of such delegation by the Board of Harbor Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach by and through the Board of Harbor Commissioners purchased in 2011 certain property at Broadway and Golden Avenue, adjacent to the World Trade Center, more particularly described on Exhibit A which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference ("the Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners now desires to sell the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners has received several proposals for purchase and development of the Property; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Board of Harbor Commissioners to negotiate and execute the necessary documents for the sale of the Property, it is necessary that such authority be conferred upon and delegated to the Board of Harbor Commissioners with respect to the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as

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Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach, pursuant to Section 1204 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach, confers upon and delegates to the Board of Harbor Commissioners the power and duty to negotiate the sale of the Property and to take all actions and enter into any and all agreements necessary to do so.

- Sec. 2. Pursuant to such conferred and delegated powers, the Board of Harbor Commissioners shall on behalf of the City of Long Beach:
- (a) Fix and determine the terms and conditions of sale for the Property, consistent with City of Long Beach practices and policies for such sales of real property within the City of Long Beach;
- (b) Make any findings required by the California Environmental Quality Act regarding the Property; and
- (c) Take any actions which may be necessary and proper to complete the sale of the Property.
- Sec. 3. The delegation of powers and duties provided for hereinabove shall become operative on the operative date of a resolution of the Board of Harbor Commissioners approving and accepting the powers and duties so conferred and delegated.
- Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and shall cause the same to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach. This ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day after its approval by the Mayor of the City of Long Beach.
