FIFTIETH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

**24289**

THIS FIFTIETH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. 24289 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of June 6, 2018 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 80 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:

"80. TROUBLESHOOT AND REPAIR LIGHTING ON BELMONT PIER.

80.1 Scope of Work. WS shall troubleshoot and repair lighting on Belmont Pier, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "BBB" and incorporated herein.

80.2 Compensation. For the services and work related to troubleshooting and repairing the lighting on the Belmont Pier, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Thirty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$32,750).

80.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions

1 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,  
2 shall apply to troubleshooting and repairing the lighting on the Belmont Pier.”

3 2. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions  
4 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and  
5 confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

**RE: Troubleshoot and Repair Lighting on Belmont Pier**

Ms. Elvira,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to troubleshoot and repair the lighting for the Belmont Pier in Long Beach. A detailed description of the work is listed below.

CLP will rent an Underbridge Inspection Truck in order to access the lighting circuit that is located under the pier. The entire circuit utilizes SO Cord and our pricing assumes that we may have to replace portions. We have estimated that this work will take approximately one (1) week and the costs for such are included in the price. The estimated cost to complete this project is **Thirty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$32,720)**. This work should be performed on a Time & Material basis due to the fact that we are unsure what work will be required to repair the lighting on the pier, which could be less than what we have quoted.


