

RESOLUTION NO. RES-06-0076

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE 20-YARD REAR LOADERS AND 28-YARD AUTOMATED SIDE LOADERS THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND MCNEILUS TRUCK AND MANUFACTURING, INC. (THE MCNEILUS COMPANIES)

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase rear loaders and automated side loaders; and

WHEREAS, the Long Beach Unified School District (the "District") has a contract for the purchase of these vehicles, Purchase Order No. P928189 ("District PO"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the District PO will facilitate acquisition of these vehicles as well as provide considerable costs benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the District PO considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated by this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to

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1 enter an agreement with McNeilus Truck and Manufacturing, Inc. to purchase three (3) 20-  
2 yard rear loaders and six (6) 28-yard automated side loaders of substantially the same type  
3 and kind purchased by the District pursuant to the District PO except as modified by mutual  
4 agreement of the City of Long Beach and McNeilus Truck and Manufacturing, Inc. and the  
5 purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded  
6 to the District in an amount not to exceed \$2,059,257 plus tax plus a 10% contingency.


7 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the  
8 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
