A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH CONFIRMING, READOPTING AND AMENDING FILING FEES FOR PROCESSING VARIOUS LAND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. C-25064

WHEREAS, on June 11, 1991, the City Council of the City of Long Beach adopted Resolution No. C-25064 establishing fees for the processing of developer-related activities and for processing permits by the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to maintain fees at a level sufficient to recover the costs of processing various land development activities through the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the fees set forth in this resolution have not been revised since June 11, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That existing fees for processing of land development-related activities by the Department of Public Works shall be as follows:

C. Records Search and Records Copying

For providing staff assistance in the area of records search and records copying, the fee shall be as determined in accordance with the Fee Schedule on file in the Office of the City Engineer. Fees for such service shall not be applicable where

costs are recovered under other rules, regulations, resolutions, or ordinances. On or before the first of August of each year, the City Engineer shall review and adjust the Fee Schedule as necessary to maintain fees at a level sufficient to recover related costs.

Sec. 2. Resolution No. C-25064 is hereby rescinded.

Sec. 3. The purpose of the fees herein imposed is to recover for the City its costs of administering and providing the service for which the fee is levied. Such fee or fees do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing services necessary to the activity for which the fee is charged and is not levied for unrelated revenue purposes.

Sec. 4. Constitutionality, Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the sections, sub-sections, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional. Additionally, the determination of an unconstitutional or invalid section, subsection, clause or phrase shall have the effect of reviving the prior section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase as previously set forth in Resolution
