A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AFFIRMING THE ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS OF AND ALSO ADOPTING THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE LONG BEACH GENERATION STATION EMERGENCY REPOWERING PROJECT AND MAKING FINDINGS RELATING THERETO

WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Long Beach ("Board") at its meeting of April 2, 2007 adopted Resolution No. HD-2358, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, wherein the Board, among other things, adopted the Negative Declaration for the Long Beach Generation Station Emergency Repowering Project ("Project").

WHEREAS, Californians for Renewable Energy (CARE) (including their members or officers Michael Boyd and Lynne Brown) and Coalition for a Safe Environment (CFASE) (including their members or executive director Jesse Marquez, Gabrielle Weeks, and Tom Politeo) (collectively, "Appellants") appealed the adoption of the subject Negative Declaration pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21151(c) and Long Beach Municipal Code Section 21.21.507; and

WHEREAS, the appeal was placed on the City agenda of the City Council and Appellants had notice and opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds on the basis of the whole record before it that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment and that the Negative Declaration reflects the Board's independent

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judgment and analysis as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act.

Sec. 2. Based on the above recitals, findings, and determinations, the City Council hereby affirms the adoption by the Board of Harbor Commissioners of and also adopts the Negative Declaration for the Long Beach Generation Station Emergency Repowering Project and rejects the appeals of all Appellants in their entirety.

Sec. 3. The Managing Director of Environmental Affairs and Planning for the Harbor Department, whose office is located at 925 Harbor Plaza, Long Beach, California 90802, is hereby designated as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the City Council's decision is based, which documents and materials shall be available for public inspection and copying in accordance with the provision of the California Public Records Act (Government Code Section 6250 et seq.).

Sec. 4. The Managing Director of Environmental Affairs and Planning for the Harbor Department shall file a notice of determination with the County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles and with the State Office of Planning and Research.

Sec. 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.

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RESOLUTION NO. HD- 2358

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION AND APPLICATION SUMMARY REPORT FOR THE LONG BEACH GENERATION STATION EMERGENCY REPOWERING PROJECT, APPROVING THE PROJECT, AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS RELATIVE THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach, acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board"), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") and as the permitting authority under the California Coastal Act, caused the preparation of a Negative Declaration ("ND") and Application Summary Report ("ASR") describing the Long Beach Generation Emergency Repowering Project ("Project") and discussing the environmental impacts resulting therefrom; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Project is to meet the demand for electricity during peak electricity use events by partially repowering the existing Long Beach Generation Station; and

WHEREAS, the Project is a permitted use under the Port Master Plan for the Terminal Island Harbor Planning District; and

WHEREAS, the Project is consistent with the goals and objectives for this District, including utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board on February 12, 2007 issued the ND/ASR for public and agency comments; and

WHEREAS, the comment period for the ND/ASR closed on March 14, 2007 and comments were received; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed and considered the ND and ASR, and any communications regarding the ND/ASR.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

- Section 1. <u>Findings Preparation and Review of Negative Declaration</u> and Application Summary Report. The Board finds as follows:
 - 1.1 The ND and ASR for the Project were prepared by staff for the Board.
 - 1.2 The ND/ASR was issued on February 12, 2007 to responsible agencies and interested persons.
 - 1.3 The comment period closed on March 14, 2007 and comments were received.
 - 1.4 A copy of the ND and ASR are available for inspection in the office of the Managing Director of Environmental Affairs and Planning and are by this reference made a part hereof.
 - 1.5 Members of the Board have been provided copies of the ND and ASR and related documents. The Board has reviewed and considered the information contained in these documents together with any communications regarding these documents prior to approval of this resolution.
- Sec. 2. <u>Findings Conformity with Port Master Plan</u>. The Board finds on the basis of the whole record before it that the Project is in conformity with the Port Master Plan, as a permitted use consistent with the goals and objectives of the Plan.
- Sec. 3. <u>Findings No Significant Effect and Independent Judgment</u>. The Board finds on the basis of the whole record before it that there is no substantial evidence that the Project will have a significant effect on the environment and that the ND/ASR reflects the Board's independent judgment and analysis as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act.
 - Sec. 4. Adoption and Approvals. Based on its review and consideration

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of the ND/ASR, all written and oral communications regarding the Project which have been submitted to and received by the Board, and the findings and determinations set forth above, the Board:

- 4.1 Adopts the ND/ASR, including the special conditions set forth therein.
 - 4.2 Approves the Project.
- 4.3 Approves the issuance of a Level II Harbor Development
 Permit pursuant to the California Coastal Act, certified Port Master Plan, and
 Article XII, Section 1215 of the Long Beach City Charter.

Sec. 5. <u>Location and Custodian of Record Proceedings</u>. The Managing Director of Environmental Affairs and Planning of the Long Beach Harbor Department, whose office is located at 925 Harbor Plaza, Long Beach, California 90802, is hereby designated as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the Board's decision is based, which documents and materials shall be available for public inspection and copying in accordance with the provisions of the California Public Records Act (Cal. Government Code Sec. 6250 et seq.)

Sec. 6. <u>Notice of Determination</u>. The Managing Director of Environmental Affairs and Planning shall file a Notice of Determination with the County Clerk of the County of Los Angeles.

Sec. 7. <u>Certification</u>, <u>Posting and Filing</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Harbor Commissioners, and the Secretary of the Board shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution and shall cause a certified copy of this resolution to be filed forthwith with the City Clerk. The City Clerk shall post the resolution in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.
