

This letter is in favor of Preferential Parking District "AC" on the west side of Cherry Ave. between Roosevelt Road and Marshall Place. I've attended all three of the previous meetings but in case I'm unable to attend the City Council meeting on Dec. 1, 2015, I'd like to add a few words.

Long Beach City Council,

When we bought our home on Cherry Ave. in the sixties there was a pipe yard across the street, a one-way service road that had parking on both sides of the street (even the Long Beach Bus drove down our service road) and Cherry Ave. had only four lanes.

A few years later a Volkswagen business was built across the street and our one-way service road was narrowed so Cherry Ave. could have five lanes.

Now the home-owners could only park on one side of the service road, except on street-sweeping days.

When Simmons Volkswagen moved in after Bill Berry Volkswagen, they eventually added the Subaru business. The present owner does not furnish enough parking for his employees so many of them park in

front of our homes and jay-walk
across Cherry Ave. every day from
early morning until they close around
9:00 P.M. Some days there are even
un-licensed vehicles parked in front
of our homes all day.

If the owners of the businesses on
the east side of Cherry Ave. would provide
sufficient parking for their employees we
would not have this problem.

Please let us try Preferential Parking!
