

RESOLUTION NO. RES-23-0132

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING CITY MANAGER TO
EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT A
GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA NATURAL RESOURCES
AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,200,000 FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS AT WRIGLEY GREENBELT
RESTOTATION PROJECT AND MULTI-SERVICE CENTER
EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have
approved a grant for the project shown above; and

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated
the responsibility for the administration of the grant project, setting up necessary
procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural
Resources Agency require the Grantee to certify by resolution the approval of a Project
Information Package before submission of said package to the State; and

WHEREAS, City of Long Beach ("Applicant") desires to enter into an
agreement with the State of California and accept grant funds from the California Natural
Resources Agency for capital improvements at Wrigley Greenbelt Restoration Project
and Multi- Service Center Expansion and Improvements Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, if awarded, Applicant intends to accept an amount up to Five
Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,200,000) for completion of the Project and
authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute all documents necessary to accept
the funds and implement the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

1 follows:

2 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
3 herein by this reference.

4 Section 2. Approves the acceptance of a general fund allocation for
5 assistance for the Wrigley Greenbelt Restoration Project and Multi-Service Center
6 Expansion and Improvement Project; and

7 Section 3. Certifies that the City understands the assurances and
8 certifications in the Project Information Form; and

9 Section 4. Certifies that the City will have sufficient funds to develop,
10 operate and maintain the projects consistent with the land tenure requirements of the
11 Grant Agreement; or will secure the resources to do so; and

12 Section 5. Certifies that the City will comply with the provisions of
13 Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.

14 Section 6. Certifies that the projects will comply with any laws and
15 regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA),
16 legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws,
17 environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable
18 licenses and permits will have been obtained.

19 Section 7. Certifies that the City has reviewed and understands the
20 General Provisions contained in the sample Grant Agreement contained in the
21 Procedural Guide; and

22 Section 8. Appoints the City Manager as agent to conduct all
23 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to the Project
24 Information Form, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for
25 the completion of the Wrigley Greenbelt Restoration Project and Multi-Service Center
26 Expansion and Improvement Project.

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Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
