SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 30332

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT No. 30332 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 1, 2013 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on July 10, 2007, by and between KONICA MINOLTA BUSINESS SOLUTIONS, U.S.A. Inc., a New York corporation, with a place of business at 879 W. 190th Street, # 200, Gardena, CA 90248 ("Konica"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with providing hardware, software and maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, City selected Konica in accordance with City's administrative procedures and City has ascertained that Konica and its employees are qualified, licensed, and experienced in performing such specialized services; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Agreement No. 30332 on November 19, 2007 for a term of five (5) years wherein Konica agreed to provide the specialized services; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the term for an additional year;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of Agreement No. 30332 is hereby deleted in its entirety and amended to read as follows:
- "3. TERM. The term of this Agreement shall commence on September 15, 2013 and shall terminate on September 15, 2014. The term of this Agreement may be extended by the execution of a written agreement by the City Manager of CITY. Each business transaction may have a different term and that term will
