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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CELLCO  
6 PARTNERSHIP DBA VERIZON WIRELESS TO PROVIDE  
7 MOBILE DEVICES AND CELLULAR AND DATA SERVICE  
8 PLANS, ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS  
9 AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF UTAH, THROUGH THE  
10 NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF STATE PROCUREMENT  
11 OFFICIALS (NASPO) VALUEPOINT MASTER  
12 AGREEMENT

14 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section  
15 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor  
16 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and  
17 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

18 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase mobile devices and  
19 cellular and data service plans; and

20 WHEREAS, Cellco Partnership dba Verizon Wireless has an Agreement  
21 with the State of Utah, Contract No. MA-52-1 ("Utah Contract") through the National  
22 Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement; and

23 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Utah Contract will facilitate timely  
24 acquisition of the mobile devices and cellular and data services plans as well as provide  
25 considerable cost benefits to the City; and

26 WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than  
27 participate in the Utah Contract considerably more funds would be required;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

1 follows:

2                   Section 1.    The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
3 herein by this reference.

4                   Section 2.    The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter  
5 an agreement and any amendments thereto with Cellco Partnership dba Verizon  
6 Wireless to provide mobile devices and cellular and data service plans on substantially  
7 the same terms afforded to the State of Utah, under the National Association of State  
8 Procurement Officials (NASPO) ValuePoint Master Agreement, in an annual amount not  
9 to exceed Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,00), until the NASPO contract  
10 expires on August 11, 2024, with the option to renew for as long as the NASPO contract  
11 is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

12                  Section 3.    This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
13 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
