3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
4 OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL
5 CODE BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 14.14.050 (A) RELATING
6 TO CANOPIES IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA

8 The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

10 Section 1. Subsection 14.14.050 (A) of the Long Beach Municipal Code is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 A. Canopy structures, including overhead structures and
13 windbreaks, are permitted, provided such structures are approved as part
14 of a public walkway occupancy permit and are consistent with limitations
15 imposed by the Redevelopment Agency as part of an approved master
16 plan or design guidelines. Such structures must comply with all applicable
17 laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, all fire, health, and
18 building code regulations, and shall be a medium-toned beige or shall
19 match the color of the adjacent building. Signage on or adjacent to a
20 canopy structure shall be limited to business identification signs and shall
21 be included in the calculation of total signage permitted pursuant to
22 Chapter 21.44 of this code.

24 Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the
25 City Council of the City of Long Beach and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous
26 places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is
27 approved by the Mayor.
