RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the Permit, with or without conditions, or deny the Permit on the application of CLE All Stars Café, Inc., DBA La Lune Restaurant, 1458 Atlantic Avenue, for a Permit for Entertainment With Dancing by Patrons at an existing Restaurant. (District 6)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before a license or permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved, a short-term one-year permit shall be approved, or the application should be denied.

Attached for your review is the application from CLE All Stars Café, Inc., DBA La Lune Restaurant. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved with conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Long Beach Development Services Department recommends that the permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons be approved.

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a restaurant since September 2000.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of July 8, 2008, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers on June 20, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Inspection \$300 and Zoning Review \$14 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$1,000 (Police Department), Temporary Permit \$300, Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department), and Health/Noise Control \$94 (Health and Human Services Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$299.88 and Regulatory \$825 (Financial Management Department).





APPLICATION FOR ENTERTAINMENT WITH DANCING AT LA LUNE

RESTAURANT - 1458 ATLANTIC AVENUE

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for Entertainment <u>With</u> Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following sixteen (16) conditions of operation:

La Lune is a restaurant located on the southeast corner Atlantic Avenue and New York Street. The restaurant serves Asian food and is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. The permittee will provide entertainment activities for wedding receptions, dinner banquets, and birthday parties. The permittee will not provide any type of nightclub entertainment for the general public.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION


- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be allowed <u>only</u> during pre-planned events such as weddings, banquets, receptions, and birthday parties. Special events that are open to the public must be pre-approved by the Long Beach Police Vice Detail, no later than seven (7) days prior to the scheduled event.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than midnight Sunday through Thursday nights, and 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) The permittee shall not hold any events or hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 5) Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.

- Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- During any entertainment activity listed on page #7 of the application, the permittee shall be responsible for maintaining an adequate security staff to supervise patrons inside the establishment and the parking lot. For crowds up to fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) security guard. For crowds over (50) fifty people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Security guards must be identifiable as "La Lune employees." Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase staff, or employee uniformed licensed security guards, as directed by the Chief of Police.
- A security guard shall conduct hourly checks of the parking lot and the immediate area during any entertainment activity. This security guard shall ensure that patrons do not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area. They shall also ensure the patrons enter and leave the parking lot in a peaceful manner as not to disturb any nearby residents. The permittee shall also post a sign indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors." The Chief of Police may increase or relax this condition, based on calls for service related to problems in the parking lot.
- 9) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 10) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- 11) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 12) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business, which is a restaurant. In the event the primary business ceases operations on a permanent basis, meaning meals are no longer offered at the location, the entertainment permit becomes null and void.

- 14) La Lune, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 15) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 16) If the permittee acquires an Alcohol Beverage Control license, he shall, within ninety (90) days, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.



The Community Design and Development Division of Long Beach Development Services has the following comments:

A review of the permit history for 1458 Atlantic Avenue, indicates that one Conditional Use Permit Exemption was approved for alcohol sales (Case No. 02-05), but no CUPs or AUPs were found for the subject property.

The subject property is located within the Community Automobile-Oriented District (CCA). Within the CCA district, dancing by patrons is permitted as an accessory use for a restaurant.

The subject site has previously been approved for an entertainment permit with dancing in 2001. As a result of an ownership change, the new owners are now seeking to obtain a permit for entertainment with dancing. As the applicants are not seeking to expand the dance floor area, no extra parking is required.

Planning Bureau recommends that the entertainment permit with dancing for "La Lune Restaurant" be approved.
