RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant the Permit, with conditions on the application of Pacific Sailing, LLC, DBA Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club, 423 Shoreline Village Drive #D, for a Social Club Permit. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before a Social Club permit is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires that the City Council make a determination that the application is complete and truthful; where the applicant is an entity, it is a bona fide entity, organized and conducted for a lawful purpose; the applicant, the person interested in the ownership and operation of the entity, and the officers and trustees of the entity are law-abiding persons who will operate and conduct the business activity in a lawful manner; and, that the public peace, welfare, and safety will not be impaired. If this is so, the application shall be approved; if not, it shall be denied.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or, 2) deny the Permit on the application.

Attached for your review is the application from Pacific Sailing, LLC, DBA Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club. Also attached are reports from various departments and a summary of those reports, as well as the license history of the establishment.

City departments have conducted their investigation in accordance with the LBMC. The following summarizes their findings:

- The Police Department recommends that the permit for a social club be approved subject to conditions.
- The Fire Department recommends that the permit for a social club be approved.

- The Health and Human Services Department finds that the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department recommends that the permit for a social club be approved.

The Department of Financial Management, Business Relations Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for a social club be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or licenses are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Social Club since April 1990.

Deputy City Attorney Cristyl Meyers reviewed this item on May 13, 2009.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of June 2, 2009, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$20 and Zoning Review \$14 (Development Services Department), Police Investigation \$636 (Police Department), and Labels \$90 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License \$309.77 and Regulatory \$265 (Financial Management Department).

Recommended Conditions of Operation

Pacific Sailing, LLC DBA Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club 423 Shoreline Village Drive #D Application for a Social Club Permit

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) No adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12:00 midnight, Sunday thru Thursday nights, and 0200 hours, Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of social club activities or by offering non-amplified activities.
- Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club or any space under its control shall not be rented to any member of the general public for any use, including private parties or events. All attendees for any meeting, event, or activity, including social club activities, shall be dues paying members of the Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club.
- Where applicable, an application for membership shall be in writing, and each permittee shall establish a membership committee which shall review and act upon each application. An appropriate identification card shall be issued to each person approved for membership. The term "member" includes a dues-paying member, honorary member, associate member, lifetime member, or any other person granted a membership in the licensed entity. The term "registered member" is any person who pays dues, any other remuneration, or is otherwise a member in good standing.
- 7) No person shall be admitted to membership or granted temporary, provisional or limited membership rights within twenty-four hours after his/her application is submitted.

- 8) Every social club shall keep on its premises at all times a membership book or register which shall contain a complete and current roster of the entire membership. It shall list the name, address, and type of membership of each member.
- 9) No person shall apply for membership under any false or fictitious name or any name and address other than the true name and address of such person. False information in the membership book or register may constitute grounds for revocation or suspension of the permit.
- 10) It shall be the duty of every permittee and of every employee, manager, agent or officer of such permittee to display and exhibit such membership book or any other document or record relevant to this Section to any police officer or other authorized public employee in the pursuit of his/her official duties on the demand, oral or written, of such police officer or public employee.
- 11) No card games or card playing is allowed where there is an exchange of money or anything else of value or anything which represents anything of value. Card games or card playing shall be allowed only for the purpose of entertainment and amusement. The definition of amusement for the purposes of this Section shall mean any game or contest between two or more persons which is either skill or chance and which is played solely for the purpose of enjoyment and not for any consideration, monetary or otherwise.
- The permittee shall employ his/her own discretion in determining the level of security necessary to prevent violations of law and any other disturbances arising out of or in connection with social club operations. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.
- 13) At the conclusion of all social club activities, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting members walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 14) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times open for members and staff. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- The permittee shall not allow staff/employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.

- The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 17) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any social club activities.
- 19) Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 20) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- The permittee shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved social club permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this 90 day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.





In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for a Social Club Permit, which includes Entertainment with Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following twenty-one (21) conditions of operation:

Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club is located at the south end of Shoreline Village. The establishment is a members-only club that will provide various activities and entertainment for its members. Based on the Police Department's investigation, and the South Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, the Long Beach Police Department does not believe the issuance of a Social Club permit will have an adverse impact on Patrol Division resources.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application shall be restricted to no later than 12:00 midnight, Sunday thru Thursday nights, and 0200 hours, Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4) Noise emanating from the permittee's premises shall not be audible 50 feet or more from the exterior of the premises. The permittee shall be responsible for determining how to best meet this requirement, either by keeping doors and windows shut, limiting hours of entertainment or by offering non-amplified entertainment.
- Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club or any space under its control shall not be rented to any member of the general public for any use, including private parties or events. All attendees for any meeting, event, or activity, including entertainment, shall be dues paying members of the Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club.

SOCIAL CLUB PERMIT AT PACIFIC SAILING & YACHT CLUB 423 SHORLINE VILLAGE DRIVE #D Page 2

- Where applicable, an application for membership shall be in writing, and each permittee shall establish a membership committee which shall review and act upon each application. An appropriate identification card shall be issued to each person approved for membership. The term "member" includes a dues-paying member, honorary member, associate member, lifetime member, or any other person granted a membership in the licensed entity. The term "registered member" is any person who pays dues, any other remuneration, or is otherwise a member in good standing.
- 7) No person shall be admitted to membership or granted temporary, provisional or limited membership rights within twenty-four hours after his/her application is submitted.
- 8) Every social club shall keep on its premises at all times a membership book or register which shall contain a complete and current roster of the entire membership. It shall list the name, address, and type of membership of each member.
- 9) No person shall apply for membership under any false or fictitious name or any name and address other than the true name and address of such person. False information in the membership book or register may constitute grounds for revocation or suspension of the permit.
- 10) It shall be the duty of every permittee and of every employee, manager, agent or officer of such permittee to display and exhibit such membership book or any other document or record relevant to this Section to any police officer or other authorized public employee in the pursuit of his/her official duties on the demand, oral or written, of such police officer or public employee.
- No card games or card playing is allowed where there is an exchange of money or anything else of value or anything which represents anything of value. Card games or card playing shall be allowed only for the purpose of entertainment and amusement. The definition of amusement for the purposes of this Section shall mean any game or contest between two or more persons which is either skill or chance and which is played solely for the purpose of enjoyment and not for any consideration, monetary or otherwise.
- The permittee shall employ his/her own discretion in determining the level of security necessary to prevent violations of law and any other disturbances arising out of or in connection with business operations. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 13) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 14) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 17) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320)
- 18) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- 19) Pacific Sailing & Yacht Club, or its agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 20) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, the more stringent regulation shall apply.
- 21) The permittee shall, within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this 90 day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
