3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PURIFICS
6 WATER, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, FOR
7 THE COMMISSIONING AND STARTUP OF STORMWATER
8 FILTRATION EQUIPMENT FOR THE LONG BEACH
9 MUNICIPAL URBAN STORMWATER TREATMENT
10 PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT OF \$146,480, WITH A 15%
11 CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,972, FOR A
12 TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$168,452, FOR A
13 PERIOD OF ONE YEAR, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW
14 FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIODS, AT THE
15 DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

17 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits the
18 City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without
19 advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor for actual
20 emergency work when authorized by resolution; and

21 WHEREAS, on April 3, 2018, City Council approved the recommendation to
22 execute a contract with Purifics Water, Inc. for the purchase of stormwater filtration
23 equipment for the Long Beach Municipal Urban Stormwater Treatment (LB-MUST) Project;
24 and

25 WHEREAS, the equipment has been delivered to the City's storage facility
26 and paid in full. Construction of the LB-MUST Facility began in November 2021 and the
27 equipment will be moved later this year where it will be installed, commissioned, and
28 started-up; and

1 WHEREAS, Purifics Water, Inc. equipment is a proprietary system protected
2 by foreign and domestic patents; thus, commissioning and startup services for this
3 equipment can only be provided by Purifics Water, Inc.; and

4 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
5 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and unnecessary expenditure
6 of public funds;

7 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
8 follows:

9 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
10 with Purifics Water, Inc., without advertising for bids, for the commissioning and startup of
11 stormwater filtration equipment for the Long Beach Municipal Urban Stormwater Treatment
12 Project in an amount of One Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars
13 (\$146,480) with a fifteen percent (15%) contingency of Twenty-One Thousand Nine
14 Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$21,972) for a total not to exceed amount of One Hundred
15 Sixty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$168,452) for a period of one (1)
16 year, with option to renew for two (2) additional two-year periods, at the discretion of the
17 City Manager.

18 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
19 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
