Municipal Election is ordered, proclaimed and called to be held in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Councilmanic
District in the City of Long Beach, California, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00
P.M. on Tuesday, the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2006, to fill the Office of Member of the City
Council for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Councilmanic District for the remainder of the present term which
terminates on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of July, 2008.

The candidate receiving a plurality of the votes cast for 2 all candidates shall be deemed to be and declared by the City Council to be elected to 3 the Office of Member of the City Council for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Councilmanic District for the 4 remainder of the present term which terminates on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of July, 2008. 5 Nomination papers shall be filed during the period commencing on February 27, 2006, 6 at 7:30 A.M. and ending at 4:30 P.M. on March 10, 2006. All other particulars shall be 7 held in accordance with the provisions of law governing the conduct of such elections in 8 9 the City of Long Beach.
