RECOMMENDATION:

Receive the supporting documentation into the record, conclude the hearing and grant an Entertainment Permit with conditions on the application of Toshco, LLC, dba The Good Bar and Eatery, 3316 E. 7th Street, for entertainment without dancing. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Long Beach Municipal Code (LBMC) requires an application be filed and a hearing be held before the City Council whenever this type of activity is requested and before an entertainment permit (Permit) is granted or denied.

The LBMC also requires the City Council to approve the issuance of the Permit if they find that: the issuance of the Permit at the proposed location is consistent with federal, state and local laws, rules, and regulations; it will not constitute an undue burden on the neighborhood; the applicant(s) or responsible persons have not been convicted of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude or felony offense within the past five years; and, neither the applicant(s) or any responsible persons have a history of committing significant violations of the City code and have not provided false or misleading information on their application.

The City Council has the authority to approve the following options: 1) grant the Permit, with or without conditions; or 2) deny the Permit on the application. Once the Permit is granted, pursuant to LBMC 5.72.120.5, the Permit will be subject to an administrative review by the Financial Management Department every two years. This review process will consist of a multi-department analysis to determine compliance and identify if issues exist. This provision does not affect the City's ability to modify, revoke or suspend a permit at any time.

City departments have conducted their investigations in accordance with the LBMC. Attached for your review are the departmental investigative reports, history, entertainment permit application and floor plan. To review entertainment forms online, you may visit http://www.longbeach.gov/finance/services-and-permits/entertainment-permit.

The following summarizes departmental findings:

- The Police Department recommends the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved subject to the conditions.
- The Fire Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.
- The Health and Human Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use with the condition that the establishment remain in compliance with the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- The Development Services Department finds the building/location meets department requirements for the proposed use.

The Financial Management Department, Business Services Bureau, has reviewed all submitted department documents and correspondence and, after a thorough investigative process, recommends that the permit for entertainment without dancing be approved subject to conditions (attached).

In the event that any of the recommended conditions are in conflict with other permits or licenses, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. This location has been licensed as a Bar/Tavern/Lounge since February 2004. The business changed ownership to Toshco, LLC, in December 2015.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy R. Webber on July 24, 2017.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

The hearing date of August 15, 2017, has been posted on the business location, with the applicant and property owners within 300 feet notified by mail.

FISCAL IMPACT

The following fees were collected with the application: Building Review \$22.45 and Zoning Review \$16.50 (Development Services), Police Investigation \$1,255.00 (Police Department), and Temporary Entertainment Permit \$380.00, and Mailing List \$90.00 (Financial Management Department).

The following fees will be collected if the application is approved: Business License Annual Tax \$355.25, Employee Rate \$18.45 per employee, and Annual Entertainment Regulatory Fee \$305.00 (Financial Management Department).

Toshco, LLC. DBA The Good Bar and Eatery 3316 E. 7th Street
Application for Entertainment Without Dancing

The Department of Financial Management recommends **approval** of the Permit subject to the following conditions:

I. STANDARD CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- 1) The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- 2) Unless separately applied for, reviewed, and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LMBC Chapter 8.80).
- 4) This Entertainment Permit is accessory to the primary business. The authorization to provide entertainment on-site is subject to the use remaining a bona fide eating place serving actual and substantial meals.

"Meals" means the usual assortment of foods commonly ordered at various hours of the day; the service of such food only as sandwiches or salads shall not be deemed compliant with this requirement. Meals must consist of food prepared on the premises. Hours of sales of alcohol shall be limited to the hours when meals are available.

The premises must be equipped and maintained in good faith. The premises must possess working refrigeration, cooking equipment, utensils, menus, and enough food to make substantial meals.

In the event the primary business ceases operation, fails to operate as a bona fide eating place, fails to serve actual and substantial meals, or otherwise fails to comply with this condition, the Entertainment Permit becomes null and void.

5) Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and windows shall be kept closed at all times during any entertainment, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) is not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction. Outdoor amplified entertainment is prohibited.

- 6) The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.
- 7) Deliveries to and from the premises shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.
- 8) The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) uniformed security guard during all times that the entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50) people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional uniformed security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaint/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 9) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times while open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and signage indicating words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors" or something similar.
- 10) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the front of the establishment, the parking lot or the immediate area.
- 11) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City for all costs associated with excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 12) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request. (LBMC section 18.48.320).
- 13) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the licensee, shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- 14) The business, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter such as signs, posters, or promotional cards, in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.

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The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, and phone numbers, on file at all times, and be available for inspection at any time.

- 15) The permittee shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub activities.
- 16) The permittee shall install and maintain a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business with full view of the public right-of-ways and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. The video system must be capable of delineating on playback the activity and physical features of persona and areas within the premises. Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 17) The permittee shall within ninety (90) days of an approved entertainment permit, submit proof of attending the LEAD program offered by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. In the event that the LEAD program class is not offered within this ninety day period, the permittee shall attend the next available class. Proof of completion shall be submitted to the Long Beach Police Department Vice Investigations Section.
- 18) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances, and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict with the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

II. ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application must cease by 10:00 pm Tuesday through Thursday and 12:00 midnight on Friday and Saturday.
- 2) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- III. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license is in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions. In addition, please be advised that your permit is subject to administrative review every two years from the date this permit is issued. If grounds exist for revocation or suspension of the permit, a hearing will be held.



APPLICATION FOR ENTERTAINMENT WITHOUT DANCING AT THE GOOD BAR AND EATERY – 3316 EAST 7TH STREET

In response to your request for a recommendation regarding the above named permit application for an Entertainment <u>Without</u> Dancing, the Police Department recommends **approval**, subject to the following twenty-two (22) conditions of operation:

The Good Bar and Eatery is a restaurant that serves American style bar food and is located on the south side of 7th Street between Coronado Avenue and Redondo Avenue. The restaurant is owned by a Limited Liability Company, Toshco, who has owned and operated The Good Bar and Eatery since September 2015. Toshco, LLC currently holds a Type 47 (On-Sale General Eating Place) Alcoholic Beverage Control license. On January 19, 2016, The Good Bar and Eatery applied for an Entertainment Permit without Dancing, requesting live music by more than two performers, live and recorded amplified music, karaoke, and a disc jockey.

Based upon the crime analysis, Vice Section's investigation, the East Division Patrol Commander's recommendation, and input from area residents, the Long Beach Police Department has determined the public's peace, safety, and welfare would not be adversely impacted by the issuance of this permit, provided the appropriate conditions are imposed and observed by the applicant. The Police Department recommends approval of an Entertainment without Dancing Permit.

CONDITIONS OF OPERATION

- The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities and elements expressly indicated on the permit application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the approved permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
- Unless separately applied for, reviewed and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 5.72.115(B) LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
- 3) Entertainment activities indicated on page #7 of your entertainment application must cease by 10:00 pm Tuesday through Thursday and 12:00 midnight on Friday and Saturday.

- 4) The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise Ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
- Due to the proximity of neighboring businesses and residences, all door(s) and window(s) shall be kept closed at all times during any musical entertainment, except in cases of emergency, and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) shall not consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door. Sound shall not be audible beyond fifty feet (50') from the exterior of the premises in any direction.
- The permittee shall not allow employees to discard trash or beer bottles into the outside dumpster between the hours of 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.
- 7) The permittee shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the premises and the area adjacent to the licensed premises over which they have control.
- 8) The permittee shall provide security personnel to monitor the area under their control and the entrances and exits for the location at all times that entertainment is provided.
- The permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) licensed security guard during all times that entertainment activities are being conducted for crowds up to fifty (50) people. For crowds over fifty (50 people, the permittee shall provide a minimum of one (1) additional security guard per fifty (50) people. Patrons awaiting entry in a defined queue shall be counted toward the calculation of required security staffing levels.

The attire of each security guard shall clearly indicate the guard's affiliation with the establishment by means of a pin, shirt, or other visible form of identification. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for police service, or trash left in the parking lot, the permittee shall increase security staff, implement the use of electronic metal detection equipment, increase outside lighting, or make other changes to the premises or operation as the Chief of Police determines are necessary to protect the safety of the public.

- 10) The permittee shall take reasonable measures to prohibit and prevent the loitering of persons immediately outside any of the entrance/exit doors and the parking lot, at all times open for business. This should be done by use of security guards and/or signage indicating, words to the effect of, "Please respect our neighbors."
- 11) At the conclusion of each event, the permittee shall take reasonable measures to ensure that exiting patrons walk directly to their vehicles, and not loiter in the immediate area, or block the sidewalk from the free flow of pedestrian foot traffic.

- The permittee shall not convert the restaurant, or any portion thereof, into a public dance/night club. All entertainment activities shall be conducted in conjunction with **regular dining** or **pre-planned banquet activities**. A banquet is defined as a function held at a bonafide eating place wherein complete and substantial meals are provided to the persons in attendance by the management of the restaurant where the function is being held. Fast food, snacks, and hors d'oeuvres shall not constitute a complete and substantial meal.
- 13) The permittee or any client shall not hire promoters with the intent to advertise/promote or hold any entertainment activities consistent with nightclub entertainment.
- The Good Bar and Eatery shall not advertise, procure, nor allow any person, performance, show, promotion, or any other event or entertainment that exposes or promotes, encourages, or allows the exposure of the male or female genitals, cleft of the buttocks, the areola or any portion of the female breast below the areola, while at or inside the business.
- The Good Bar and Eatery, its promoters, or agents, shall not distribute any advertising matter in or upon any public property, or in or on any vehicle in any such place in the City. Distribution of any advertising matter upon private property shall adhere to the following guidelines: By placing the same matter in a receptacle, clip, or other device designed or intended to receive advertising matter.
- 16) The permittee shall keep all promoter contracts, including names, addresses, phone numbers, and business license, on file at all times and be available for inspection at any time.
- 17) Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the permittee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time and provide that information to public safety personnel upon request.
- 18) The permittee agrees to reimburse the City whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of, or in connection with the permittee's operations.
- 19) The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions. In the event of a conflict between the requirements of this permit, your conditional use permit, or your Alcoholic Beverage Control license, the more stringent regulation shall apply.

- The permittee shall be responsible for installing and maintaining a video surveillance system that monitors no less than the front and rear of the business, with full view of the public right-of-ways, and any parking lot under the control of the permittee. These cameras shall record video for a minimum of 30 days and be accessible via the Internet by the Long Beach Police Department. A Public Internet Protocol (IP) address and user name/password is also required to allow the Long Beach Police Department to view live and recorded video from these cameras over the internet. All video security cameras shall be installed to the satisfaction of the Chief of Police, Director of Technology Services, and Director of Development Services. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, the permittee may be required to add additional video cameras.
- 21) Any graffiti painted or marked upon the premises, or on any adjacent area under the control of the permittee shall be removed or painted over within 24 hours of being applied.
- The permittee shall ensure that all employees attend an alcohol awareness class such as TIPS or LEAD, within the first ninety (90) days of employment. The permittee shall keep employee's proof of completion on file, and be available for inspection at any time.
