FOURTH AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 32723

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 32723 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of January 1, 2015 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on April 19, 2005, by and between PARENTS ANONYMOUS, INC., a California nonprofit corporation, with offices located at 250 W. First Street, Suite 250, Claremont, California 91711 (hereafter "Subcontractor"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a California municipal corporation (hereafter "Contractor" or "City").

WHEREAS, Contractor has entered into a Contract for City's Family Preservation Program (hereafter "Prime Contract") with the County of Los Angeles (hereafter "County"); and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its obligations to County under the Prime Contract, Contractor desires to engage Subcontractor to provide community preservation network services; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Subcontract No. 32723 whereby Subcontractor agreed to perform such work; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the contract term to June 30, 2016 and increase the contract sum by \$300,000 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$720,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions contained in the Subcontract and this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of Subcontract No. 32723 is amended to read as follows:
- "3. <u>TERM OF SUBCONTRACT</u>. The term of this Subcontract shall commence on July 1, 2012 and shall expire on June 30, 2016, unless terminated earlier pursuant to any of the conditions for termination in the Prime Contract."
 - 2. Section 4 of Subcontract No. 32723 is amended to read as follows:
- "4. <u>PAYMENT</u>. Contractor shall compensate Subcontractor a total maximum contract sum not to exceed Seven Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars

(\$720,000) for the term of this Subcontract to provide the services designated in Section 2.0 of this Subcontract."

- Exhibit "B" to the Subcontract is hereby replaced by Exhibit "B-1", 3. attached hereto and incorporated by this reference.
- Except as expressly amended in this Fourth Amendment, all terms 4. and conditions in Subcontract No. 32723 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

Attendance at the CFPN Monthly Network meeting is required. Executive Director or designee to attend at least two (2) Network meetings per contract year.

DEFINITION OF SERVICES

PARENTING TRAINING

Interactive groups, which provide caregivers with mutual support, training and enhancement of parenting skills, and child development education, which includes alternative discipline and impulse control. Groups are designed to raise self-awareness and understanding, develop insight into personal issues and problem solving towards creating a healthy and safe home environment. Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family.

ANGER MANAGEMENT COUNSELING

Face-to-face meetings/interventions by a counselor with an individual, couple, family or group to address and treat anger management issues. Sessions are designed to assist participants in identifying emotions managing stress, controlling behavior, resolving conflict and improving communication. Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family.

CHILD FOCUSED ACTIVITIES

Activities designed to enhance a child's growth and development that are age appropriate and provided a the same time the parents are receiving Family Preservation services. These services will be offered to the children of the families attending Parenting Training and/or Anger Management Counseling.

Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family. Subcontractor shall invoice per family for all children participating in a particular child focused activity at the same time. Subcontractor may invoice individually if the children in a family participate in separate activities.

FAMILY PRESERVATION BASE RATE

Family Preservation Base Rate Services include weekly in-Home Outreach Counseling visits with all members of the family designated in the service plan, clinical direction, attendance to the Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC) and all required documentation in compliance with requirements in the prime contract.

IN-HOME OUTREACH COUNSELING

Based on the professional status, licensed, MA/MSW under licensed supervision or BA, this service includes additional in-home outreach counseling visits as assigned by the client's service plan and or Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC)

SUBSTITUTE ADULT ROLE MODEL (SARM)

This is a face to face contact with children or youth as assigned by the service plan and or Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC) to mentor and foster positive behavior through the adult's example and to broaden the child or youth's recreational, social and educational dreams through shared experiences.

TEACHING AND DEMONSTRATION (T&D)

This is a face to face contact to provide services to caregivers as assigned by the service plan and or Multidisciplinary Case Planning Committee (MCPC) in which worker demonstrates and teaches primary caregivers the skills to successfully manage and maintain a home including, but not ilmited to, home safety, cleanliness, meal planning and budgeting.

CHILD FOLLOW-UP

The in-Home Outreach Counselor (iHOC) shall make a subsequent visit whenever a child(ren) is absent during the in-Home counseling session.

Subcontractor will provide all services in compliance with requirements in the Prime Contract and the Family Preservation Program Statement of Work (Exhibit A-2 of the Prime Contract). Subcontractor will be responsible for all related administrative functions, including but not limited to: all required case documentation and reporting.

<u>UP FRONT ASSESSMENT</u>

This is a face to face contact with DCFS referred parent to provide a screening using the Behavioral Severity Assessment Tool (BSAP). The up-front assessor produce a written report from the face to face screening using the web-base BSAP that will must sent to referring DCFS office. The up front assessment require timely deadlines as stated in the prime contract.
