



RE: LED Conversion – Rainbow Harbor

Mr. Solhjou,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install light emitting diode (LED) lamps and fixtures in Rainbow Harbor, Long Beach. CLP's pricing is based on quantities and lamps and fixtures selected by the City of Long Beach and their consultants. A detailed description is listed below.

- 1. Remove MH lamp and replace with Phillips TrueForce LED – 55ED28/LED/740/ND 120/277V G2 4/1 LED lamp. Once converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the lamps or fixtures are working properly.
 - (199) – Post-top poles/bollards (Walkway-Vehicle accessible) \$61,642
 - (92) – Post-top poles/bollards (Gangway/Dock-No vehicle accessible) \$31,294
- 2. Remove existing flood light fixture and replace with ABS Lighting Series 5700LED. Once converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the lamps or fixtures are working properly.
 - (32) – Flood light on high-mast poles \$64,080
- 3. Remove existing parking lot shoebox fixture and replace with Lithonia D-Series Size 1. Once converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the lamps or fixtures are working properly.
 - (8) – Parking lot fixtures \$17,153

Total cost for this work is **One Hundred Seventy-Four Thousand One Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$174,170)**

Assumptions: Fixtures/lamps selected are compatible with existing fixtures, arms and attachments.
