3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH IMPLEMENTING GOVERNMENT
5 CODE SECTION 20636(c)(4) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 20691 BY PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
7 EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS FOR LONG
8 BEACH ASSOCIATION OF ENGINEERING EMPLOYEES TO
9 THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
10 SYSTEM (CalPERS)

12 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has the authority to implement
13 Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has a written labor policy or
15 agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid
16 by the employer, and reported as special compensation; and

17 WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement this section
18 is the adoption by the governing body of the City of Long Beach of a resolution giving
19 notice of its intention to commence reporting the value of employer paid member
20 contributions (EPMC) as compensation for all members of the group or class as
21 identified herein.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
23 as follows:

24 Section 1. Effective as of September 18, 2004, the governing body of the
25 City of Long Beach shall implement Government Code Section 20636(c)(4) pursuant to
26 Section 20691 by paying and reporting the value of Employer Paid Member
27 Contributions (EPMC) for all miscellaneous employees represented by the Long Beach
28 Association of Engineering Employees. This benefit shall consist of the City paying 7%

1 of the normal contributions as EPMC, and reporting the same percent value of
2 compensation earnable, excluding special compensation pursuant to Government Code
3 Section 20636(c)(4) as additional compensation. The employee shall pay 1% of the
4 normal contribution.

6 Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
7 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.
