Our 8th District Youth group is very active within our community. Your observations, suggestions, input and ideas are valuable. You are the future of our city. Together we can make a difference.

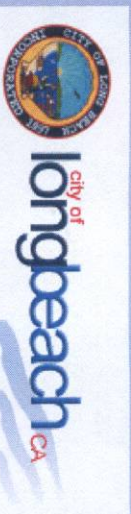

As a member of the Youth Advisory Council you will share many experiences that benefit your community while also building your community service hours.



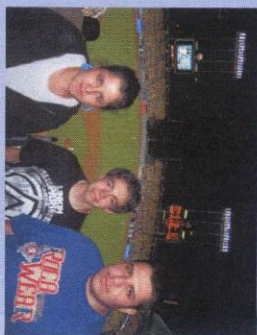
