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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO PURCHASE EIGHTEEN REAR LOADER
6 REFUSE TRUCKS THROUGH THE PURCHASE ORDER
7 BETWEEN THE LONG BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL
8 DISTRICT AND LOS ANGELES TRUCK CENTERS, LLC
9 DBA LOS ANGELES FREIGHTLINER WESTERN STAR –
10 LONG BEACH
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12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
13 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
14 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
15 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase eighteen (18) Rear Loader Refuse
17 Trucks ("Refuse Trucks"); and

18 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Unified School District has a Purchase Order
19 for the purchase of these Refuse Trucks, Purchase Order No. P980152 ("LBUSD
20 Purchase Order"); and

21 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the LBUSD Purchase Order will
22 facilitate acquisition of these Refuse Trucks as well as provide considerable cost benefits
23 to the City; and

24 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
25 LBUSD Purchase Order considerably more funds would be required;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
27 follows:

- 28 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein

1 by this reference.

2 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an
3 agreement with Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC dba Los Angeles Freightliner Western
4 Star – Long Beach to purchase eighteen (18) Rear Loader Refuse Trucks of substantially
5 the same type and kind purchased by the Long Beach Unified School District pursuant to
6 the LBUSD Purchase Order except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Los
7 Angeles Truck Centers, LLC dba Los Angeles Freightliner Western Star – Long Beach,
8 and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the
9 Long Beach Unified School District in an amount not to exceed \$4,817,740, including tax
10 and shipping, plus a five percent (5%) contingency for equipment adjustments if
11 necessary and if funds are available, for a period extending until the warranty on the
12 Refuse Trucks expires.

13 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the
14 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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
