3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH MIDEO
6 SYSTEMS, INC., WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS,
7 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A COMPREHENSIVE
8 SOFTWARE UPGRADE FOR THE LONG BEACH POLICE
9 DEPARTMENT'S CRIME LABORATORY'S EXISTING
10 SOFTWARE SYSTEM, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
11 \$103,200

13 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Police Department's Crime Laboratory ("Crime
14 Lab") desires to improve the quality and timeliness of services; and

15 WHEREAS, the Crime Lab currently uses Mideo Systems, Inc. ("Mideo")
16 software, Caseworks; and

17 WHEREAS, minimal training will be required for the upgrade because the
18 Crime Lab staff has gone through significant training for their current Mideo software; and

19 WHEREAS, Mideo provides innovative forensic comparisons including
20 firearms and latent fingerprints and their engineers have created a new comparison
21 workflow system that is the only software system that allows for effective case
22 management as well as for examiner to digitally/electronically document comparisons
23 that helps and supports the Crime Lab's transition to international accreditation; and

24 WHEREAS, Mideo Systems, Inc. is the sole manufacturer and distributor of
25 Caseworks products; and

26 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
27 for bids for furnishing this software and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act
28 and an unnecessary expenditure of public funds;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
2 follows:

3 Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract,
4 without advertising for bids, with Mideo Systems, Inc. for the purchase of a
5 comprehensive software upgrade for the Long Beach Police Department's Crime
6 Laboratory's existing software system in an amount not to exceed \$103,200.

7 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
8 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
