RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys and walkways in the City of Long Beach in connection with the conduct of the 2015 Formula Drift Pro Championship. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The 10th Annual Formula Drift Pro Championship will be held in Long Beach from April 10 through 11, 2015. This event will attract over 25,000 people to the City. In order to allow for the staging of this event, a Resolution has been prepared, which provides for the temporary closure of a portion of Shoreline Drive between Ocean Boulevard and Shoreline Village Drive and various adjacent streets described in the Resolution. This area will be used as part of the venue for the festival, which will also be held on the Marina Green and at Rainbow Lagoon Park. Additional space is required for the safety of event attendees due to projected attendance figures.

Access to the Shoreline Marina and Shoreline Village will be via Shoreline Village Drive. Directional signage shall be provided to clearly direct traffic to these areas. The appropriate City Departments have reviewed the requested closure plans.

Traffic management and signage plans shall be shared with the public through various media outlets.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard Anthony on June 17, 2014 and by Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on June 18, 2014.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on July 1, 2014, in order to expedite the execution of the Resolution in time for the event, which is scheduled for April 10 through 11, 2015.

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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS, AND WALKWAYS IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 2015 FORMULA DRIFT PRO CHAMPIONSHIP

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the temporary closing of the streets, described herein, is necessary for the safety and protection of the participants and spectators in the 2015 Formula Drift Pro Championship to be held from April 10, 2015 through April 11, 2015.

Section 2. For the conduct of the 2015 Formula Drift Pro Championship, the following streets, alleys, and walkways are hereby temporarily closed for the periods stated:

A. On April 10, 2015 and April 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to eastern end of Seaside Way, Linden Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Locust Avenue to Collins Way, Atlantic Way from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Hart Place to eastern end, Linden Avenue, northbound and southbound from Shoreline Drive to Marina Parking lot, and Locust Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way.

B. On April 10, 2015 and April 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Shoreline Drive westbound from Ocean Boulevard and Alamitos intersection to Shoreline Village Drive.

1 C. On April 10, 2015 and April 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
2 p.m., Shoreline Drive eastbound from Shoreline Village Drive to Ocean
3 Boulevard and Alamitos intersection.

4 D. On April 10, 2015 and April 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
5 p.m., walkway off of Seaside Way from Hart Place to the east end of
6 Seaside Way.

7 Section 3. The temporary closing of the above streets, alleys, and
8 walkways, for the times herein provided is necessary for the safety and protection of the
9 participants and spectators in the 2015 Formula Drift Pro Championship and qualifying
10 events to be held from April 10, 2015 through April 11, 2015, utilizing the streets
11 described herein.

12 Section 4. For the period April 10 and 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
13 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.A. are hereby withdrawn
14 and removed from public use.

15 Section 5. For the period April 10 and 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
16 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.B. are hereby withdrawn
17 and removed from public use.

18 Section 6. For the period April 10 and 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
19 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.C. are hereby withdrawn
20 and removed from public use.

21 Section 7. For the period April 10 and 11, 2015 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00
22 p.m., the streets, alleys and walkways described in Section 2.D. are hereby withdrawn
23 and removed from public use.

24 Section 8. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed
25 to post notices of the intent to temporarily reduce lanes, close the streets, alleys,
26 walkways described in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 above at least twenty-four (24) hours
27 prior to the closure thereof.

28 Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
