SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 30899

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO SUBCONTRACT NO. 30899 FOR VETERANS AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (this "Subcontract") is made and entered, in duplicate, as of October 13, 2009 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on August 14, 2007, by and between SINGLE PARENTS UNITED 'N' KIDS, a California nonprofit corporation ("Organization"), with offices located at 2125 Santa Fe Avenue, Long Beach, California 90810, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation (the "City").

WHEREAS, the City has received monies from the County of Los Angeles ("County") pursuant to Contract Number AO-08-060 for Homeless Veterans Initiative ("County Contract") for a program that aims to develop a comprehensive service package to improve and enhance specialized services for homeless veterans in the City; and

WHEREAS, as part of the County Contract, the City desires to enter into subcontracts with certain organizations that provide veterans and mental health services to homeless veterans in the City and Organization has been selected as a sub-recipient of monies under the County Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered Subcontract No. 30899 whereby Organization agreed to provide these services to the City; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend this Subcontract to clarify that specified disbursements are amounts made to Organization on an annual basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in Subcontract No. 30899 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 4.B. of Subcontract No. 30899 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- "4.B. Total disbursements made to Organization under this Subcontract by the City shall not exceed Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) per year over the

term of this Subcontract. These funds shall be used to provide services within the City. Upon execution of this Subcontract, the City shall disburse the funds payable hereunder in due course of payments following receipt from Organization of billing statements in a form approved by the City showing expenditures and costs identified in Attachment "B"."

2. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions in Subcontract No. 30899 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
