A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH FINDING THAT THE USE OF TAXES ALLOCATED TO THE NORTH REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT ON BEHALF OF THE CENTRAL REDEVELOP-MENT PROJECT FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING, IMPROVING AND PRESERVING THE COMMUNITY'S SUPPLY OF LOW- AND MODERATE-INCOME HOUSING WILL BE OF BENEFIT TO THE NORTH REDEVELOP-MENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach,
California (the "Agency"), adopted redevelopment plans for the North Long Beach
Redevelopment Project (the "North Project") and the Central Long Beach
Redevelopment Project (the "Central Project"); and

WHEREAS, Section 33334.2 of the California Community Redevelopment
Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.) requires that not less than twenty
percent (20%) of all taxes allocated to each project area be used by the Agency for the
purpose of increasing, improving and preserving the community's supply of low- and
moderate-income housing available at affordable housing cost; and

WHEREAS, the Agency desires to utilize funds presently allocated to the
North Project to assist the Central Project in meeting its twenty percent (20%) set aside
obligation; and

WHEREAS, Section 33334.3 of the Community Redevelopment Law
provides that the Agency may use such funds in this manner if a finding is made by
resolution of the Agency and the City Council that such use will be of benefit to the
North Project;
