

I respectfully request Council concurrence and ABC approval of the following conditions:

1. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control.
2. The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited.
3. Trash shall not be emptied into outside containers between the hours of 12:00 am – 7:00 am.
4. There shall be no live entertainment of any type, including but not limited to live music, disc jockey, karaoke, male or female performers or fashion shows.
5. There shall be no dancing allowed on the premises.
