FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 30773

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 30773 (this "Amendment") is made and entered, in duplicate, as of June 10, 2008, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on June 10, 2008, by and between MOFFATT & NICHOL, a California corporation ("Consultant") and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Agreement No. 30773 (the "Contract") whereby Consultant agreed to perform engineering and design work for the restoration of the Colorado Lagoon in the City of Long Beach ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to clarify the procedures under which Consultant shall be compensated for services performed in connection with the Project, without increasing or decreasing the total compensation to be paid to, or the scope of services to be provided by, Consultant.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in the Contract, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The phrase "at the rates or charges described in Exhibit 'F" is hereby deleted from the first sentence of Section 1 of the Contract.
 - 2. Exhibit "F" is hereby deleted in its entirety from the Contract.
- 3. The first sentence of Section 1.3 of the Contract is amended and restated in its entirety to read "Consultant has requested to receive regular monthly payments based on the completed percentage of each task included within the Scope of Work.".
- 4. The "Part 2 Fee" schedule attached to the Contract in Exhibit "C" is hereby replaced by the "Part 2 Fee" schedule attached to this Amendment as Exhibit "C".
- 5. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions of the Contract are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
