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## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING TABLE 41-1C OF CHAPTER 21.41, AND SECTION 21.45.114 (2), (5) and (8). ALL RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

MANUFACTURING AND ACCESSORY TASTING ROOMS

Section 1. Table 41-1C of Chapter 21.41 of the Long Beach Municipal Code relating to Alcoholic Beverage Manufacturing and Accessory Tasting Room Use is amended to read as follows:

5	gross floor area (GFA), unless otherwise permitted by an Administrative

7	5. An ABM and accessory tasting room may not be located				
8	within five hundred (500) feet of the nearest property line of any				
9	elementary, secondary, or high school, as measured from the nearest				
10	property line of the site on which the alcohol manufacturing use is located,				
11	unless located in PD-30 (Downtown Plan), or permitted by Conditional				
12	Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with Section 21.52.201.				
13	8. The ABM and accessory tasting room use shall not be open				
14	to the public, except for the following hours:				
15	Manufacturing & Production: 7:00 a.m 7:00 p.m. Monday				
16	- Saturday; and				
17	Accessory Tasting Room (Industrial Zone): 12:00 p.m. –				
18	9:00 p.m. Sunday – Thursday, and 11:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Friday –				
19	Saturday.				
20	Accessory Tasting Room (Commercial Zone): 12:00 p.m				
21	9:00 p.m. Sunday - Thursday, and 11:00 a.m 11:00 p.m. Friday-				
22	Saturday. Additional hours may be permitted through an Administrative				
23	use Permit (AUP). The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this
