A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR AND TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR FUNDING FOR THE RED CAR GREENWAY TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Transportational Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century provides funds to the State of California to be used for the acquisition, development and maintenance of motorized and non-motorized trails; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Parks and Recreation ("Department") has the responsibility for administration of the grants funds; and

WHEREAS, the Department requires that the applicant for grant funds approve submission of the application by resolution; and

WHEREAS, if the City's application for grant funds is approved, the City must enter an agreement with the Department with respect to its use of the grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to submit an application for the development of the bicycle and pedestrian trail on the Pacific Electric Right-of-Way between Walnut Avenue and Martin Luther King Avenue, known as the Red Car Greenway Trail Project ("Project"), in the amount of \$206,455.00 and, if the City receives grant funds, to conduct all negotiations, accept all funds, execute and submit all

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1 documents including but not limited to agreements, amendments, payment requests, and  
2 all other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the Project, and  
3 implement and administer the funds and all things related to the Project.

4 Sec. 3. The City certifies that it has or will have available prior to  
5 commencement of work on the Project sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project.

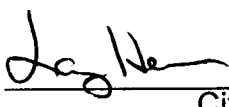
6 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately on its adoption by the
