FOURTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of November 1, 1997 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995 by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a Colorado corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to place electrical service underground and CLP agreed to do so; and

WHEREAS, said Contract also included (by reference to Assessment Contract No. 24288) a provision whereby the City could choose to include Other Lights in the conversion; and

WHEREAS, City desires to place a portion of electrical service underground, to convert lighting in certain City parks and to add lighting in other parks, and to clarify procedures relating to payment; and

WHEREAS, CLP assigned its interest in Lighting Contract No. 24289 to WS, with the approval of the City and all further obligations for performance under Lighting Contract No. 24289 and all references in Lighting Contract No. 24289 to CLP shall hereafter refer to WS;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the

parties agree as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 1.8(a) of Lighting Contract No. 24289 which allows the City to authorize WS to place electrical service underground, Section 17 is hereby added to Lighting Contract No. 24289 to read as follows:

"17. GOLDEN AVENUE UNDERGROUND.

"17.1 <u>Underground Work</u>. WS shall convert the overhead electrical service for street lights to underground electrical service for that portion of Golden Avenue between Broadway and Sixth Street (the "Golden Avenue underground work") in accordance with the standards and terms and conditions in this Contract.

"WS shall do the Golden Avenue underground work in cooperation with Southern California Edison Company.

- "17.2 <u>Compensation</u>. For the services relating to the Golden Avenue underground work, City shall pay to WS a lump sum of Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Fifty-nine Dollars (\$14,159.00) following completion of the Golden Avenue underground work by WS. City shall pay WS in due course of payments following submission by WS of an invoice identifying the Golden Avenue underground work."
- 2. In accordance with Section 1.0(b) of Lighting Contract No. 24289 and, by reference, Assessment Contract No. 24288, which allows the City to include park lighting in Other Lights, Section 18 is hereby added to Lighting Contract No. 24289 to read as follows:

"18. PARK LIGHTING-GENERAL.

"18.1 <u>Park Lighting</u>. WS shall convert the City's park lighting, consisting of one thousand three hundred sixty-seven (1,367) lights in thirty-three (33) parks in the same manner, within

the same time period, and as described for the Street Light System in this Contract. WS shall also install eighty (80) additional lights at nine (9) parks. The work described in this Section 18.1 shall be referred to as "general park lighting."

- park lighting (conversion and new installations), the City shall pay to WS an increase in the Basic Fee (including the Assignable Portion of the Basic Fee) by One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) annually, beginning on December 1, 1997, for the remaining term of the Contract. This change in the Basic Fee is shown on Exhibit 'D-1'.
- "18.3 <u>Conditions</u>. Any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Light System contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, shall apply to the general park lighting."
- 3. Section 16 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby amended by the addition of the following subsections:
- "16.4 Additional Lights. WS shall add eight (8) lights on four (4) light poles that CLP has previously relocated in Recreation Park at the Billie Jean King Tennis Center.
- "16.5 Additional Compensation. For the services relating to Section 16.4, City shall pay to WS a lump sum of Five Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$5,868.00) following completion of the work by WS. City shall pay WS in due course of payments following submission by WS of an invoice identifying the additional work."
- 4. Exhibit "D" to Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby replaced with Exhibit "D-1", attached hereto and incorporated herein

5. Except as expressly amended herein, in the First Amendment, the Second Amendment, and the Third Amendment to Lighting Contract No. 24289, all of the terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
