3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO PURCHASE CONSULTING SERVICES
6 THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF
7 LOS ANGELES AND THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
8 CORPORATION OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY, A
9 CALIFORNIA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION (MORE
10 COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE LAEDC)

12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
13 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
14 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
15 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the City desires consulting services to analyze and prepare a
17 report on the likely fiscal and economic impact of raising the minimum wage in the City;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has a Contract with The Economic
20 Development Corporation of Los Angeles County, a California non-profit corporation
21 (more commonly referred to as the "LAEDC") for the purchase of these consulting
22 services, Contract Number AO-15-050 ("County Contract"); and

23 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the County Contract will facilitate
24 acquisition of these consulting services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to
25 the City; and

26 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
27 County Contract considerably more funds would be required;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

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1 follows:

2 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
3 herein by this reference.

4 Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an
5 agreement with the LAEDC for consulting services to analyze and prepare a report on the
6 likely fiscal and economic impact of raising the minimum wage in the City of substantially
7 the same type and kind purchased by the County of Los Angeles pursuant to the County
8 Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and the LAEDC, and the
9 purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the County of
10 Los Angeles in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000).

11 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
12 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

13 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City
14 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of September 15, 2015
