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WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires consulting services to analyze and prepare a report on the likely fiscal and economic impact of raising the minimum wage in the City; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has a Contract with The Economic Development Corporation of Los Angeles County, a California non-profit corporation (more commonly referred to as the "LAEDC") for the purchase of these consulting services, Contract Number AO-15-050 ("County Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the County Contract will facilitate acquisition of these consulting services as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the County Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as

follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to enter an agreement with the LAEDC for consulting services to analyze and prepare a report on the likely fiscal and economic impact of raising the minimum wage in the City of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the County of Los Angeles pursuant to the County Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and the LAEDC, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the County of Los Angeles in an amount not to exceed Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000).

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption Section 3. by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
