RESOLUTION NO. RES-10-0088

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) THROUGH THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FAIRFAX COUNTY, VIRGINIA AND HAGEMEYER NORTH AMERICA, INC.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach ("City"), Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) from Hagemeyer North America, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fairfax, Virginia has a contract for the purchase of Personal Protective Equipment under Contract No. RQ06-814063-10A and Amendment No. 4 ("Fairfax Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Fairfax Contract will facilitate acquisition of the Personal Protective Equipment as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Fairfax Contract, considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated hereby by this reference.

Section 2. The City Manager of the City is hereby authorized to approve

1 a purchase order with Hagemeyer North America, Inc. to purchase Personal Protective
2 Equipment of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the County of Fairfax,
3 Virginia pursuant to the Fairfax Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the
4 City and Hagemeyer North America, Inc., and the purchase by the City shall be on the
5 same terms and conditions afforded to the County of Fairfax, Virginia in an amount not to
6 exceed \$75,000, including tax, to be funded by Homeland Security Grant UASI-08.

7 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
8 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

9 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City
10 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of August 10, 2010 by the
