Restore positions in Homeland Security Section - \$579,884 . Chief's priorities for additional restorations - \$3,175,357 b) Fire Department: \$4.3 million . Maintain four-person staffing on engines - \$3,243,198 . Restore engine at Station 18 - \$262,388 . Restore Rescue 12 - approx. \$800,000 c) Library Services: \$750,000 . Maintain existing services at Neighborhood Libraries - \$703,727 .
