Dear Sir or Madam:

At its meeting of June 22, 2004, the City Council approved your application for a permit for entertainment with dancing by patrons at 6400 E. Pacific Coast Highway, Long Beach, CA 90803. The entertainment activities and entertainment hours from page 7 of the Entertainment Application (attached) were approved with the following conditions:

1. The operation of the establishment shall be limited to those activities expressly indicated on the permit of the application and approved by the City Council. Any change in the operation, which exceeds the conditions of the permit, will require that a new permit application be submitted to the City Council for their review and approval.
2. Unless separately applied for, reviews and approved, no adult entertainment, as defined by section 21.15.110 LBMC shall be conducted on the permitted premises.
3. Current occupancy loads shall be posted at all times, and the licensee shall have an effective system to keep count of the number of occupants present at any given time. (LBMC Section 18.48.320)
4. No owner, operator or manager shall permit any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years within the premises at any time during the hours of operation.
5. There shall be no outdoor entertainment allowed at any time.
6. The door(s) or windows shall be kept closed at all times during any indoor entertainment activity described in your application, except in cases of emergency and to permit deliveries. Said door(s) are not to consist solely of a screen or ventilated security door.
7. No sound shall be audible from the exterior of the premises in any direction.


8. The permittee shall employ his/her own discretion in determining the level of security necessary to prevent violations of law and any other disturbances arising out of or in connection with business operations. Should the permittee's operations give rise to a substantial increase in complaints/calls for service, the permittee shall increase security as directed by the Chief of Police.
9. If any noise, disturbance complaints, or trash left in the parking lot and surrounding area of the business can be attributed to the operation of said business, the Police Department can determine and impose requirements for security officer presence to routinely police and handle these problems.
10. The permittee agrees to reimburse the city whenever excessive police services, as determined by the Chief of Police, are required as the result of any incident or nuisance arising out of or in connection with the permittee's operations.
11. All promoters must have or obtain a City of Long Beach Business License prior to conducting entertainment activities governed by this permit. The permittee shall be responsible for all entertainment activities at the location, including those by promoters.
12. The permittee must provide all promoters hired to conduct entertainment activities with a copy of the approved permit, which shall include a copy of the approved conditions of operation.
13. The permittee shall maintain full compliance with all applicable laws, and ABC laws, ordinances and stated conditions.
14. The establishment shall remain in compliance with all applicable sections of the Long Beach Noise ordinance (LBMC Chapter 8.80).
15. Permittee shall comply with the Fire Department conditions:
  - a. Immediately remove all locking hardware from all doors, gates, etc.
  - b. Scissor gate (entrance) shall be locked open when in use.
  - c. Remove all cords from in front of the Exit Doors paths.
  - d. Provide California State Fire Marshall Certificates for flame resistance of all decorative materials.
  - e. Occupancy may be limited to a maximum of posted occupant loads when operated independent and a maximum of 299 when operated simultaneously.
  - f. Provide a sketch or layout to Long Beach Fire Department for evaluation of occupant loads.
16. Permittee shall comply with Planning and Building Department conditions:
  - a. Remove extension cords being used as permanent wiring.
  - b. Provide fronts and label circuits at electrical panel.
  - c. Obtain electrical and building permits to create storage room

Failure to comply with conditions 15 and 16 by April 27, 2005, shall render the City Council approval of your permit null and void. In the event that any of the recommended conditions attached to any permit or license are in conflict, the permittee shall adhere to the strictest of the applicable conditions.
