3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO ACQUIRE ONE (1) FIRE MOBILE COMMAND  
6 UNIT THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STATE  
7 OF MARYLAND AND LDV, INC.  
8

9 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the  
10 City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government  
11 agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when  
12 authorized by resolution; and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase one (1) fire mobile  
14 command unit; and

15 WHEREAS, the State of Maryland has a contract for the purchase of these  
16 fire mobile command units, Purchase Order No. DGSP1003237 ("Maryland Contract"); and

17 WHEREAS, City's participation in the Maryland Contract will facilitate  
18 acquisition of this fire mobile command unit as well as provide considerable cost benefits  
19 to the City; and

20 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the  
21 Maryland Contract considerably more funds would be required;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
23 follows:

24 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated  
25 herein by this reference.

26 Sec. 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby authorized to  
27 enter an agreement with LDV, Inc. to purchase one (1) fire mobile command unit of  
28 substantially the same type and kind purchased by the State of Maryland pursuant to the

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1 Maryland Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City of Long Beach and  
2 LDV, Inc. and the purchase by the City of Long Beach shall be on the same terms and  
3 conditions afforded to the State of Maryland in an amount not to exceed \$645,708.00  
4 including tax, for a period extending until the warranty on the fire mobile command unit  
5 expires.


6 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the  
7 City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
