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RESOLUTION NO. RES-16-0046

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION
FOR THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND SUSTAINABLE
COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State of California, the Strategic Growth Council (SGC) and
the Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) has issued a
Notice of Funding Availability dated January 29, 2016 (NOFA), under the Affordable
Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program established under Division 44,
Part 1 of the Public Resources Code commencing with Section 75200; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to apply for the AHSC Program
funds and submit the application package released by the Department for the AHSC
Program; and

WHEREAS, the SGC is authorized to approve funding allocations for the
AHSC Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, AHSC Program
guidelines, application package, and standard agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Department is authorized to administer the approved funding
allocations of the AHSC Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
follows:

Section 1. The City of Long Beach (Applicant) is hereby authorized and
directed to apply for and submit to the Department the AHSC Program Application as
detailed in the NOFA dated January 29, 2016, for the 2015-16 Fiscal Year in a total amount
not to exceed \$17,723,734.00 of which \$14,196,749.00 is requested as a loan for an
Affordable Housing Development (AHD) ("AHSC Loan") and \$3,526,985.00 is requested
for a grant for Housing-Related Infrastructure (HRI), Sustainable Transportation

1 Infrastructure (STI), Transit-Related Amenities(TRA) or Program (PGM) activities (“AHSC
2 Grant”) as defined the AHSC Program Guidelines adopted by SGC on December 17, 2015.
3 If the application is approved, the Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to enter into,
4 execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement (Standard Agreement) in a
5 total amount not to exceed \$17,723,734.00 (\$14,196,749.00 for the AHSC Loan and
6 \$3,526,985.00 for the AHSC Grant), and any and all other documents required or deemed
7 necessary or appropriate to secure the AHSC Program funds from the Department, and all
8 amendments thereto (collectively, the “AHSC Documents”).

9 Section 2. Applicant shall be subject to the terms and conditions as
10 specified in the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for allowable capital asset
11 project expenditures to be identified in Exhibit “A” of the Standard Agreement. The
12 application in full is incorporated as part of the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities
13 funded, information provided, and timelines represented in the application are enforceable
14 through the Standard Agreement. Applicant hereby agrees to use the funds for eligible
15 capital asset(s) in the manner presented in the application as approved by the Department
16 and in accordance with the NOFA and Program Guidelines and Application Package.

17 Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute in
18 the name of the Applicant the AHSC Program Application Package and the AHSC Program
19 Documents as required by the Department for participation in the AHSC Program.

20 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
21 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
