### ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY **AMENDING** SUBSECTION AND BY **ADDING** SUBSECTIONS 5.72.120.H.3: 5.72.125.F ALL AND RELATING TO 5.72.120.S **ENTERTAINMENT** AND **SIMILAR** ACTIVITIES: **URGENCY** THE THEREOF: AND DECLARING DECLARING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE **EFFECT IMMEDIATELY** 

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 5.72.120.H.3 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

- H. Hearing notices.
- 3. Notice of the time and place of the hearing shall also be given:
- a. By mail to each owner of property within three hundred feet (300') of the site of the proposed activity;
- b. By mail to occupants of property within three hundred feet (300') of the site of the proposed activity;
- c. By posting the property in a conspicuous location at the site of the proposed activity.

The applicant shall pay all costs of such notice in the manner prescribed by the City's Director of Financial Management.

Subsection 5.72.120.S is added to the Long Beach Section 2. Municipal Code is to read as follows:

- S. A permit's conditions may be modified by the Director of Financial Management upon a showing that the permittee has operated in violation of any of the requirements of this Chapter, the license as issued or any condition thereof. The permittee shall be notified of the modified condition in writing no less than five (5) days prior to the effective date of the modified condition. The permittee shall have the right of appeal only of the modified condition as set for the in Section 5.06.030 of the Long Beach Municipal Code. If the permittee appeals the modified condition, the modified condition shall take effect during the pendency of the appeal.
- Section 3. Subsection 5.72.125.F is added to the Long Beach Municipal Code is to read as follows:
  - A permit's conditions may be modified by the Director of Financial Management upon a showing that the permittee has operated in violation of any of the requirements of this Chapter, the license as issued or any condition thereof. The permittee shall be notified of the modified condition in writing no less than five (5) days prior to the effective date of the modified condition. The permittee shall have the right of appeal only of the modified condition as set for the in Section 5.06.030 of the Long Beach Municipal Code. If the permittee appeals the modified condition, the modified condition shall take effect during the pendency of the appeal.
- Section 4. Declaration of Urgency. This ordinance is an emergency measure, and it is urgently required for the reason that entertainment permits must be processed immediately so that business is not interrupted in the City of Long Beach, making it necessary to immediately implement the provisions of the ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance duly adopted by
the City Council on, 2012, by a vote of at least five (5) of its
members and shall take effect immediately. The City Clerk shall certify to a separate
roll call and vote on the question of the emergency of this ordinance and to its passage
by the vote of five (5) members of the City Council of the City of Long Beach, and
cause the same to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach.
Section 6. This ordinance shall also be adopted by the City Council as
a regular ordinance, to the end that in the event of any defect or invalidity in connection
with the adoption of this ordinance as an emergency ordinance, the same shall,
nevertheless, be and become effective on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the
Mayor.
Section 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance
by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of
Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first day after it is approved by the
Mayor.
