- Request analysis of corridors and intersections with high bicycle, pedestrian, and vehicle injury crash rates to understand traffic safety issues and to help prioritize resources based on geographic areas and issues of the greatest need within 180 days.

- Request the preparation of a highly graphic and inspiring Vision Zero document stating the City's intent and providing and providing context and background for Vision Zero within 180 days.
