

1 FIFTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

3 THIS FIFTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of
4 April 4, 2019 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City
5 Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and
6 between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY
7 LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH,
8 a municipal corporation ("City").

9 WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP
10 agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

11 WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could
12 choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

13 WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided
14 in the Contract;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions
16 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

17 1. Section 86 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as
18 follows:

19 "86. LED CONVERSION - RAINBOW HARBOR.

20 86.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment for
21 the LED conversion in Rainbow Harbor, more particularly described in the proposal
22 attached hereto as Exhibit "HHH", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

23 86.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the LED
24 conversion in Rainbow Harbor, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an
25 amount not to exceed Seven Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$7,150).

26 86.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions
27 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,
28 shall apply to the LED conversion in Rainbow Harbor."

1 2. Section 87 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as
2 follows:

3 "87. LED CONVERSION - CONVENTION CENTER PARKING
4 STRUCTURE.

5 87.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment to
6 install light emitting diode (LED) retrofit kits to the existing shoebox fixtures at the
7 Convention Center Parking Structure, more particularly described in the proposal attached
8 hereto as Exhibit "III", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

9 87.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the LED
10 conversion at the Convention Center Parking Structure, City shall pay WS upon completion
11 of the services, an amount not to exceed Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Seventy
12 Dollars (\$34,470).

13 87.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions
14 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits,
15 shall apply to the LED conversion at the Convention Center Parking Structure."

16 3. Except as expressly amended herein, all of the terms and conditions
17 contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289, as previously amended, are ratified and
18 confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.


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

Mr. Solhjou,

City Light & Power, Inc. (CLP) is pleased to submit a proposal to install light emitting diode (LED) retrofit kits to the existing shoebox fixtures at the Convention Center Parking Structure, Long Beach. CLP's pricing is based on quantities and and retrofit kits selected by the City of Long Beach and their consultants. A detailed description is listed below.

Remove the 175W metal halide components from the existing shoebox fixtures and replace with a Remphos retrofit kit. Once converted, CLP will energize the circuits to ensure the fixtures are working properly.


- (18) – Wall mounted shoebox – 52W (RPT-LEDBLOCK-100L-740-10VDIM-OCC-HC419V-G3)
- (30) – Pole mounted shoebox – 99W (RPT-LEDBLOCK-150L-740-10VDIM-OCC-HC419V-G3)

Total cost for this work is Thirty One Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$34,470)
