FIFTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT TO LIGHTING CONTRACT NO. 24289

THIS FIFTY-SIXTH AMENDMENT is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 4, 2019 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on November 21, 1995, by and between WS LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("WS"), assignee of CITY LIGHT & POWER, INC., a California corporation ("CLP"), and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Lighting Contract No. 24289 whereby CLP agreed to convert the City's Street Light System; and

WHEREAS, said Contract included a provision whereby the City could choose to install, relocate or remove lighting and WS would do so; and

WHEREAS, the City desires WS to perform such additional work as provided in the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions contained in Lighting Contract No. 24289 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 86 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as follows:
 - "86. <u>LED CONVERSION RAINBOW HARBOR.</u>
- 86.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment for the LED conversion in Rainbow Harbor, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "HHH", attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 86.2 Compensation. For the services and work relating to the LED conversion in Rainbow Harbor, City shall pay WS upon completion of the services, an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$7,150).
- 86.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, shall apply to the LED conversion in Rainbow Harbor."

2. Section 87 of Lighting Contract No. 24289 is hereby added to read as 1 follows: 2 "87. CONVERSION -CONVENTION CENTER PARKING 3 4 STRUCTURE. 5 87.1 Scope of Work. WS shall furnish labor, material and equipment to 6 install light emitting diode (LED) retrofit kits to the existing shoebox fixtures at the 7 Convention Center Parking Structure, more particularly described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit "III", attached hereto and incorporated herein. 8 87.2 Compensation. 9 For the services and work relating to the LED conversion at the Convention Center Parking Structure, City shall pay WS upon completion 10 of the services, an amount not to exceed Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Seventy 11 12 Dollars (\$34,470). 87.3 Conditions. To the extent applicable, any and all terms and conditions 13 relating to the Street Lighting System in Lighting Contract No. 24289, including all exhibits, 14 15 shall apply to the LED conversion at the Convention Center Parking Structure." 16 3.
