A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH DECLARING MAY 17, 2011 "C-17 DAY", AND SUPPORTING THE PROCUREMENT OF ADDITIONAL C-17 AIRCRAFT

WHEREAS, the C-17 Globemaster III Transport Jet is a critical component of our armed force's ability to effectively deploy strategic military assets in crucial locations around the world in a timely fashion; and

WHEREAS, the ability to deploy military assets effectively and efficiently is crucial in supporting our troops overseas; and

WHEREAS, the C-17 is produced by the Boeing Company at its Long Beach facility; and

WHEREAS, ending production of the C-17 Globemaster aircraft puts at risk over 4,000 Boeing jobs and an additional 25,000 Boeing supplier jobs associated with the manufacturing of the C-17; and

WHEREAS, the C-17 is the last wide-bodied military aircraft production line in the United States, has performed superbly in both the Iraq and Afghanistan Wars, is vital to the economy of our region, and has conducted countless humanitarian missions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. To declare May 17, 2011, "C-17 Day" in the City of Long
Beach to honor this plane, the women and men who build it; and the women and men
who fly it in support of our Nation; and

Section 2. To support the continuation of the C-17 Globemaster III program, urge The Boeing Company to aggressively pursue foreign sales of the C-17, and urge the Congress of the United States to support the continuation of the C-17
