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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH QUALITY  
6 OFFICE FURNISHINGS, INC. FOR FURNISHING,  
7 DELIVERY, AND INSTALLATION OF OFFICE FURNITURE  
8 AT FUTURE LB YOUTH CENTER LOCATED AT 500 W.  
9 WILLOW STREET, ON THE SAME TERMS AND  
10 CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF  
11 CALIFORNIA (JCOC), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO  
12 EXCEED \$300,000 UNTIL THE JCOC CONTRACT  
13 EXPIRES ON JULY 1, 2023, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW  
14 FOR AS LONG AS THE JCOC IS IN EFFECT  
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16 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits  
17 the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise,  
18 without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with  
19 other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

20 WHEREAS, the City requires various office furniture, which includes, chairs,  
21 desks, couches, cubicles, and other general office furniture for the new Future LB Youth  
22 Center and the WorkPlace Adult Satellite offices located at 500 W. Willow Street; and

23 WHEREAS, Quality Office Furnishings, Inc. has a contract with Judicial  
24 Council of California, Master Contract for Furniture Vendor Services, Contract No. 4707  
25 (“JCOC Contract”); and

26 WHEREAS, the City’s participation in the JCOC Contract will facilitate  
27 acquisition of the various office furniture as well as provide considerable cost benefits to  
28 the City; and

1 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the  
2 JCOC Contract considerably more funds would be required;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
4 follows:

5 Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a  
6 contract with Quality Office Furnishings, Inc. on the same terms and conditions afforded  
7 to the Judicial Council of California (JCOC), for various office furniture at the new Future  
8 LB Youth Center and the WorkPlace Adult Satellite offices located at 500 W. Willow  
9 Street, for a total not to exceed amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000),  
10 until the JCOC contract expires on July 1, 2023, with the option to renew for as long as  
11 the JCOC is in Effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

12 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
13 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
