



1 midnight on July 1, 2008, and, unless sooner terminated as provided herein, shall  
2 terminate at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2009.

3           A. Total disbursements made to the Organization under this Subcontract  
4 by City shall not exceed \$60,000.00, per contract year, provided, however, that if City  
5 receives additional funds under the Prime Contract, then this Subcontract may be  
6 amended to increase City's disbursements to organization. City shall disburse the funds  
7 payable hereunder in due course of payments following receipt from Organization of  
8 monthly billing statements in a form approved by City for the preceding month, and  
9 conditioned on the City's receipt of the monthly progress report from Organization.

10           B. The City shall have no obligation to pay Organization until and unless  
11 City receives monthly progress reports that summarizes Organization's performance  
12 under this Subcontract during the immediately preceding month, and that describes  
13 Organization's progress in providing the services stated in Exhibit "A", Exhibit "A-1",  
14 Exhibit "A-2" and Exhibit "A-3".

15           C. City's obligation to pay Organization arises only after receipt of funds  
16 from the County under the Prime Contract.

17           D. Organization shall submit correct and final invoices on a monthly basis.  
18 Organization shall prepare and submit monthly invoices within fifteen (15) calendar days  
19 after the end of the month in which services were provided. Attached to each invoice  
20 shall be documentation to support the invoiced amounts. Failure to submit a completed  
21 invoice with proper back-up documentation may result in late payment of the invoice.  
22 The City reserves the right to refuse payment of correct and final invoices received sixty  
23 (60) days after the services were provided."

24           2. Except as expressly amended in this Third Amendment, all terms  
25 and conditions in Subcontract No. 29348 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in  
26 full force and effect.

**DEFINITION OF SERVICES**

PARENTING TRAINING

Interactive groups which provide caregivers with mutual support, training and enhancement of parenting skills, and child development education which includes alternative discipline and impulse control. Groups are designed to raise self-awareness and understanding, develop insight into personal issues and problem solving towards creating a healthy and safe home environment. Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family.

ANGER MANAGEMENT COUNSELING

Face-to-face meetings/interventions by a counselor with an individual, couple, family or group to address and treat anger management issues. Sessions are designed to assist participants in identifying emotions, managing stress, controlling behavior, resolving conflict and improving communication. Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family.

CHILD FOCUSED ACTIVITIES

Activities designed to enhance a child's growth and development that are age appropriate and provided at the same time the parents are receiving Family Preservation services. These services will be offered to the children of the families attending Parenting Training and/or Anger Management Counseling. Reimbursement will occur per hour, per family. Subcontractor shall invoice per family for all children participating in a particular child focused activity at the same time. Subcontractor may invoice individually if the children in a family participate in separate activities.
