RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the following resolutions:

1. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Long Beach giving notice of: [a] a Special Municipal Election to be held in the City of Long Beach on Tuesday, the 6th Day of November, 2012 for the purpose of submitting a ballot proposition to a vote of the qualified electors of the City; and [b] the Exhibit Ordinance;
2. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Long Beach Requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to authorize and order the consolidation of a Citywide Special Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to be held Tuesday, November 6, 2012, and determining and declaring that the City will pay to the County reasonable and actual expenses incurred by the County on account of the consolidation of this election; and
3. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to render specified services to the City relating to the conduct of a Special Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2012.

DISCUSSION

On May 22, 2012, the City Council voted to submit the proposed initiative ordinance, without alteration, for a vote of the electorate on Tuesday, November 6, 2012.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

Adoption of the suggested action will facilitate the timely filing of the proposed initiative ordinance with the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder County Clerk.

At a later date, the Office of the Mayor will docket an agenda item for the appointment of argument writers as required by the Long Beach Municipal Code.

11 WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Long
12 Beach, California on November 6, 2012; and

13 WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of these elections, it will be necessary
14 to mail sample ballots and polling place information to the registered voters of the City,
15 and it will facilitate such mailing if the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk of the County of
16 Los Angeles will make available to the City the computer record of the names and
17 addresses of all eligible registered voters in order that labels may be printed for attaching
18 to self-mailer sample ballot pamphlets; and

19 WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing this service shall be paid
20 by the City of Long Beach.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
22 follows:

23 Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 10002 of the
24 Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council requests the Board of
25 Supervisors of the County to permit the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to provide all
26 services necessary for the lawful and effective conduct of the special election to be held
27 on November 6, 2012, and make available to the City additional assistance according to
28 state law.
