ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH
MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW DISTRICT S TO
SECTION 10.32.110 CREATING A NEW PREFERENTIAL
PARKING DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority pursuant to Long Beach
Municipal Code Section 10.32.110 to create preferential parking districts in order to
alleviate serious problems relating to a shortage of available parking for residents; and

WHEREAS, after a duly noticed public hearing, the City Council determines
and finds that one hundred percent (100%) of the residents of Pavo Street adjacent to
Carver Elementary School have indicated a positive desire for preferential parking
privileges; and

WHEREAS, said area is zoned as a residential area; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a time restriction on parking in said area; and

WHEREAS, the area meets the requirements for a preferential parking
district pursuant to Long Beach Municipal Code Section 10.32.020; and

WHEREAS, Section 10.30.020 of the Long Beach Municipal Code allows
the Traffic Engineer to use reasonable judgment regarding existing limited-time parking
locations as to whether the criteria for preferential parking district would likely be met in
the absence of the limited-time restriction; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Engineer has determined that these criteria would
be met on the south side of Pavo Street between Rutgers Avenue and Montair Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does
hereby ordain as follows:

1 Section 1. District S of Section 10.32.110 of the Long Beach Municipal
2 Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 District S: The south side of Pavo Street between Rutgers Avenue and
4 Montair Avenue.

6 Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by
7 the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of
8 Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the
9 Mayor.
