8 WHEREAS, the month of October has been recognized as National Arts  
9 and Humanities Month by thousands of arts and cultural organizations, communities and  
10 states across the country, as well as by the White House and Congress for more than  
11 two decades; and

12 WHEREAS, the arts and humanities embody much of the accumulated  
13 wisdom, intellect, and imagination of humankind; and

14 WHEREAS, the arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives of every  
15 American; and

16 WHEREAS, the arts and humanities play a unique role in the lives of our  
17 families, our communities and our country; and

18 WHEREAS, the nonprofit arts and humanities industry also strengthens our  
19 national economy by generating more than \$166.2 billion in total economic activity  
20 annually and by supporting the full time equivalent of 5.7 million jobs;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
22 follows:

23 Section 1. The City of Long Beach declares the month of October to be  
24 National Arts and Humanities Month.

25 Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
