Recommendation

Adopt Specifications WD-22-016 and authorize the General Manager to execute an agreement with Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC dba Velocity Truck Center to furnish and deliver one crane truck in an amount not to exceed \$620,000.

Executive Summary

Bids for Specification WD-22-016 to furnish and deliver one crane truck were opened on February 24, 2023. Two conforming bids were received, and the bid submitted by Los Angeles Truck Centers is the lowest responsive bid.

This purchase is a scheduled fleet vehicle replacement. It is recommended that a contract in an amount not to exceed \$620,000 be awarded to Los Angeles Truck Centers, LLC dba Velocity Truck Center for one crane truck.

Fiscal Impact

The cost to the Water Fund will be incurred in FY 23, with the total amount not to exceed the contract total of \$620,000. These costs are included in the Water Fund FY 23 Budget and financial projections.
