A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE
CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE UP TO THIRTY
DIESEL PARTICULATE TRAP FILTER RETROFIT
KITS THROUGH THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
CITY OF RIVERSIDE AND VALLEY DETROIT
DIESEL ALLISON, INC. NOW KNOWN AS VALLEY
POWER SYSTEMS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits
the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other
government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective
basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to purchase up to thirty (30)
diesel particulate trap filter retrofit kits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside has a contract for the purchase of these
kits through its Contract No. G031891 ("Riverside Contract"); and

WHEREAS, City's participation in the Riverside Contract will facilitate
acquisition of these kits as well as provide considerable costs benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
Riverside Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
hereby by this reference.

1 to enter an agreement with Valley Power Systems, Inc. (formerly known as Valley
2 Detroit Diesel Allison, Inc) to purchase up to thirty (30) diesel particulate trap filter
3 retrofit kits of substantially the same type and kind purchased by the City of Riverside
4 pursuant to the Riverside Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City
5 of Long Beach and Valley Power Systems, Inc. and the purchase by the City of Long
6 Beach shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to the City of Riverside in an
7 amount not to exceed \$227,733.00 plus tax, for a period extending through December
8 31, 2005 with an option to extend for an additional year.

9 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by
10 the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
