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RESOLUTION NO. C- 28395

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH MODIFYING THE MEMBERSHIP
OF THE PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR THE
CENTRAL LONG BEACH REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Community Redevelopment Law
(Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.), the Redevelopment Agency of the
City of Long Beach, California (the "Agency") adopted the Redevelopment Plan (the
"Redevelopment Plan") for the Central Long Beach Redevelopment Project (the
"Project") on September 21, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Central Project Area Committee was formed to advise the
Redevelopment Agency on matters relating to the Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 1996, the City Council modified the membership
of the Central Project Area Committee for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2000, the City Council further modified the
membership of the Central Project Area Committee for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2003, the City Council further modified the
membership of the Central Project Area Committee for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to further modify the membership of
the Central Project Area Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves
as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby establishes the following

Sec. 2. Resolution No. C-28226 is hereby repealed.


Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
