## RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys, walkways, the Promenade, and the downtown shoreline bike path in the City of Long Beach in connection with the conduct of the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach. (District 2)

## DISCUSSION

On April 7 through April 9, 2017, the 43rd Annual Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach will be held on the streets of Long Beach. This event will attract over 180,000 people to the City and receive national and international media coverage. In order to allow for the staging of this event, a Resolution has been prepared that provides for the temporary closure of certain streets, alleys, walkways, the Promenade, and the downtown shoreline bike path so that the race may be held on City streets. The bike path, beginning at Seaside Way and Chestnut Place, and continuing to a point approximately 400 feet east of the beach parking, must be closed during the race to allow fire trucks and medical vehicles continual access to the back side of the bleachers situated on the north and south sides of Shoreline Drive. The Departments of Fire, Gas and Oil, Water, Police, Public Works, Financial Management, Development Services, Health and Human Services, and Parks, Recreation and Marine, as well as Long Beach Transit, have reviewed this schedule.

Traffic management and signage plans will be forwarded to newspapers serving the greater Long Beach area asking for their cooperation to publicize these plans as a public service during the weeks prior to the race.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Richard F. Anthony and by Assistant Finance Director Lea Eriksen on November 16, 2016.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council approval is requested on December 13, 2016, to expedite the execution of the Resolution. Construction for the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach begins on February 6, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact or local job impact associated with this recommendation.

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RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE AND REMOVE FROM PUBLIC USE CERTAIN STREETS, ALLEYS, WALKWAYS, THE PROMENADE AND DOWNTOWN SHORELINE BIKE PATH IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONDUCT OF THE 2017 TOYOTA GRAND PRIX OF LONG BEACH

The City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach finds and determines that the conduct of the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach on the streets of the City of Long Beach and the coverage thereof by the media provides a unique opportunity for the City of Long Beach to publicize and call attention to the City, its natural advantage, resources, enterprises, attractions, climate and facilities.

Section 2. For the conduct of the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach, the following streets will hereby have temporary lane reductions for the periods stated:

A. From February 6, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. to May 6, 2017 at 11:59 p.m., Shoreline Drive westbound from Ocean Boulevard to Long Beach Arena service road (reduce existing three lanes to two lanes).

B. From February 6, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to May 6, 2017 at 11:59 p.m., Shoreline Drive eastbound from Linden Avenue to Ocean Boulevard (reduce existing three lanes to two lanes).

C. From February 16, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to April 17, 2017 at 11:59 p.m., Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to Linden Avenue (reduce

1 existing two lanes to one lane in each direction, with placement of  
2 temporary stop signs at Seaside Way/Locust Avenue, Seaside Way/Collins  
3 Way, Seaside Way/Hart Place and Seaside Way/Linden Avenue.  
4 Intersection signage to be placed by City).

5 D. From February 23, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to April 11, 2017 at  
6 11:59 p.m., Pine Avenue from Ocean Boulevard south to Upper Esplanade  
7 (reduce existing five lanes to three lanes).

8 Section 3. For the conduct of the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long  
9 Beach, the following streets, alleys, promenade, walkways, and bike path are hereby  
10 temporarily closed for the periods stated:

11 A. On March 28, 2017 from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Shoreline  
12 Drive eastbound from Broadway off-ramp to Ocean Boulevard, Shoreline  
13 Village Drive to Shoreline Drive eastbound and westbound, Shoreline Drive  
14 westbound from Ocean Boulevard to Chestnut Place northbound.

15 B. On March 28, 2017 from 4:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Golden Shore  
16 on-ramp to Shoreline Drive eastbound, Chestnut Place northbound and  
17 southbound from Seaside Way to Queensway Bridge, Seaside Way from  
18 Pine Avenue to eastern end of Seaside Way, Aquarium Way from Shoreline  
19 Drive to Chestnut Avenue, Hart Place from Seaside Way to Ocean  
20 Boulevard, Collins Way from Seaside Way to Ocean Boulevard, Cedar  
21 Avenue at Shoreline Drive, Linden Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to  
22 Shoreline Drive, Bay Street at Pine Avenue and The Paseo at Pine Avenue.

23 C. On March 28, 2017 from 9:45 a.m. to 10:15 a.m., 10:45 a.m.  
24 to 11:15 a.m., 1:15 p.m. to 1:45 p.m., and 2:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m., Pine  
25 Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Upper Esplanade, Linden Avenue from  
26 Ocean Boulevard to Shoreline Drive, Seaside Way from Linden Avenue to  
27 Marina Way (eastern end).

28 D. From April 5, 2017 at 5:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.,

1 Seaside Way from Pine Avenue to eastern end of Seaside Way, Linden  
2 Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Marine Way from Locust  
3 Avenue to Collins Way, Atlantic Way from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside  
4 Way, Marine Way from Hart Place to eastern end, Linden Avenue,  
5 northbound and southbound from Shoreline Drive to Marina Parking lot,  
6 Locust Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Seaside Way, Cedar Avenue at  
7 Shoreline Drive, Bay Street at Pine Avenue, The Paseo at Pine Avenue and  
8 Aquarium Way from Shoreline Drive to Chestnut Avenue.

9 E. From April 5, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.,  
10 Shoreline Drive westbound from Ocean Boulevard and Alamitos  
11 intersection to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street on-ramp northbound, Chestnut Avenue  
12 southbound and northbound from Seaside Way to Queensway Bridge,  
13 Aquarium Way from Shoreline Drive to Chestnut Place, and Cedar Avenue  
14 at Shoreline Drive.

15 F. From April 5, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. to April 10, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.,  
16 Shoreline Drive eastbound from Broadway off-ramp to Ocean Boulevard  
17 and Alamitos intersection, Golden Shore on-ramp to Shoreline Drive  
18 eastbound, Shoreline Village Drive from Marina Parking lot to Shoreline  
19 Drive.

20 G. On April 7, 8, and 9, 2017 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Pine  
21 Avenue from Ocean Boulevard to Upper Esplanade.

22 H. On April 7, 8, and 9, 2017 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.,  
23 Promenade South from Seaside Way to Shoreline Drive Terminus.

24 I. On April 7, 8, and 9, 2017 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.,  
25 walkway off of Seaside Way from Hart Place to the east end of Seaside  
26 Way.

27 J. From April 5, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at 11:59  
28 p.m., the Bike Path beginning at Seaside Way and Chestnut Avenue east to

1 a point approximately four hundred feet (400') east of the permanent  
2 concession stand behind the Villa Riviera.

3 K. From February 6, 2017 through May 6, 2017, Shoreline Drive  
4 from Ocean Boulevard to Shoreline Village Drive, Aquarium Way between  
5 Shoreline Drive and Chestnut Place, and Pine Avenue between Seaside  
6 Way and Shoreline Drive, intermittently at the discretion of the City  
7 Manager, or his designee, in order to allow for pedestrian bridge placement  
8 and removal, but only during the hours from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.

9 Section 4. The temporary closing of the above streets, alleys, walkways,  
10 promenade and bike path for the times herein provided is necessary for the safety and  
11 protection of the participants and spectators in the 2017 Toyota Grand Prix of Long  
12 Beach and qualifying events to be held from April 7, 2017 through April 9, 2017, utilizing  
13 the streets described herein.

14 Section 5. For the period of 4:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on March 28, 2017,  
15 the streets and alleys described in Sections 3.A. through 3.C. are hereby withdrawn and  
16 removed from public use.

17 Section 6. For the period April 5, 2017 at 5:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at  
18 5:00 p.m., the streets and alleys described in Section 3.D. are hereby withdrawn and  
19 removed from public use.

20 Section 7. For the period April 5, 2017 at 7:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at  
21 5:00 p.m., the streets and alleys described in Section 3.E. are hereby withdrawn and  
22 removed from public use.

23 Section 8. For the period April 5, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. to April 10, 2017 at  
24 5:00 p.m., the streets and alleys described in Section 3.F. are hereby withdrawn and  
25 removed from public use.

26 Section 9. On April 7, 8, and 9, 2017 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., the  
27 streets, promenade and alleys described in Sections 3.G. through Section 3.I. are hereby  
28 withdrawn and removed from public use.

1                   Section 10. For the period April 5, 2017 at 6:00 a.m. to April 10, 2017 at  
2 11:59 p.m., the bike path described in Section 3.J. is hereby withdrawn and removed  
3 from public use.

4                   Section 11. From February 6, 2017 through May 6, 2017, the streets and  
5 alleys described in Section 3.K. are hereby intermittently withdrawn and removed from  
6 public use at the discretion of the City Manager, or his designee, in order to allow for  
7 pedestrian bridge placement and removal.

8                   Section 12. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized and directed  
9 to post notices of the intent to temporarily reduce lanes, close the streets, alleys,  
10 walkways and portions of the promenade described in Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10  
11 and 11 above at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the closure thereof.

12                   Section 13. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
13 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
